**NORTHERN DISTRICT**

**ROBBERY**

**LINTHICUM**

On June 2, 2009, at approximately 11:22 a.m., officers from the Northern District responded to the Extended Stay America Hotel located in the 1500 block of Aero Drive in Linthicum for a report of an armed robbery.

Upon arrival, officers spoke to the victims, employees of the hotel, who indicated that a male subject entered the hotel lobby, brandished a handgun and demanded money from the cash drawer. The employees complied with the demands of the suspect and he subsequently left the hotel with an undetermined amount of U.S. currency.

After being notified of the robbery, the manager of the hotel followed the suspect on foot and watched him get into a vehicle. The manager then blocked the suspect in with his personal vehicle. At that juncture, the suspect displayed the handgun again and demanded that the manager move his vehicle out of the way. The manager complied and last saw the vehicle on West Nursery Road heading toward I-295. The vehicle is described as possibly being a silver, four door Toyota Camry with Maryland tags.

**Suspect: Black male, approximately 6'0" with a medium build, wearing a black baseball cap, black sweat shirt with a hood and zipper, black tee shirt underneath the sweat shirt and black jeans.**

### ROBBERY

### HANOVER

On June 2, 2009, at approximately 10:52 p.m., officers from the Western District responded to the Marriott Town Place Suites located in the 7000 block of Arundel Mills Circle in Hanover for report of a robbery.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with the male victim, who reported that he was approached by a subject while parking his vehicle in the parking lot. The suspect displayed a pistol and demanded the victim's personal property. The suspect took the victim's wallet containing an undisclosed amount of U.S. currency and fled the scene in a green Dodge Caravan. The victim attempted to follow the minivan, but eventually lost sight of the van. The victim provided police with a description of the suspect and suspect vehicle; and numerous officers, a K-9 unit and an Aviation unit searched the area and the suspect was located in front of the Cinemark movie theatre. He was subsequently placed under arrest and charged with Robbery, Armed Robbery, Use of a Handgun in the Commission of a Felony, Theft Under \$500, Reckless Endangerment, First Degree Assault and Second Degree Assault.
