EASTERN DISTRICT

ASSAULT WITH INTENT TO MURDER

PASADENA

On June 5, 2009, at approximately 5:30 p.m., officers from Eastern District responded to the 400 block of Riverside Drive in Pasadena for a reported shooting.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with the 44-year-old victim, who stated that his brother had shot him in the arm during an argument and physical altercation. The victim was bleeding from an injury to the left shoulder and the suspect was still on the scene and taken into custody. The victim was transported to University of Maryland Shock Trauma by EMS. The victim was treated for injuries to the arm and chest and medical personnel discovered a projectile in his chest. Further investigation revealed that the victim actually cut his brother with a knife during the altercation and his brother was subsequently transported to BWMC, where he was treated for serious laceration to the right hand and eventually released. A high-powered competition style pellet rifle and knife believed to have been used in the assaults were recovered from the scene. Both individuals were arrested and charged in the incident.

Suspect #1: Glen Meyer, 45 of the 400 block of Riverside Drive, Pasadena, MD, was charged with Attempted 1st & 2nd Degree Murder, 1st & 2nd Degree Assault and Reckless Endangerment

Suspect #2: Kenneth Meyer, 44 of the 400 block of Riverside Drive, Pasadena, MD, was charged with 1st & 2nd Degree Assault and Reckless Endangerment

Synopsis:

On June 5, 2009, at approximately 9:40 p.m., members of the Traffic Safety Section were requested to respond to the area of Southbound Robert Crain Highway (Route 3) and Cronson Boulevard in Crofton to assist with a serious, personal injury, motor vehicle crash.

Preliminary investigation suggests that the driver, Mr. Forney, was operating a 2005 Lexus ES 330 that was traveling Southbound on Route 3 at Cronson Boulevard. The pedestrian, Mr. Miller, was attempting to cross the southbound lanes of Route 3 in the westbound direction when the Lexus struck him. Mr. Miller was not in a crosswalk at the time of the crash and the

Lexus had a green traffic signal while traveling Southbound on Route 3. The victim was projected approximately 110 feet from where he was initially struck.

Mr. Miller suffered massive upper and lower body injuries and was pronounced dead on the scene by Paramedics. Evidence at the scene suggests that Mr. Miller had consumed alcohol prior to the crash. Speed and alcohol are not believed to be factors in this crash as it relates to the driver of the Lexus. The investigation is still ongoing.

ROBBERY

SEVERN

On June 7, 2009, at approximately 2:53 a.m., officers from the Western District responded to the area of Flintlock Court and Indian Drive in Severn for a report of an assault.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with the victim, a 23-year-old male, who advised that he had driven to the area of Indian Drive near Flintlock Court to meet a friend. Once he arrived at that destination, the victim was approached by two male subjects. A brief altercation ensued between the victim and the suspects and one suspect displayed a handgun. Consequently, the victim fled on foot. As he fled, one of the suspects threatened to shoot if the victim didn't stop running and the victim eventually complied. At that time, both suspects assaulted the victim, reached into the victim's pants and took his wallet, which contained an undetermined amount of U.S. currency. Both suspects then fled the area on foot. Numerous officers canvassed the area and located one of the suspects in the immediate area. He was charged with Armed Robbery, 1st & 2nd degree Assault, Theft and Reckless Endangerment. The investigation into the second suspect continues.

Suspect 1: Santwan Dwayne Jones, 20, of the 7800 block of Willing Court, Pasadena MD 21122

Suspect 2: Black male, approximately 20-21 years old, 5'06", 160 lbs., wearing a black shirt with stripes and blue jeans

ROBBERY

GLEN BURNIE

On June 6, 2009, at approximately 4:25 a.m., officers from the Northern District with the assistance from a K-9 unit responded to the 7-11 located in the 700 block of Greenway SE in Glen Burnie for a reported robbery.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with the victim, a 29-year-old male, who stated that a male subject entered the store, approached the register with a knife and ordered the victim to open the register and hand over money. The victim complied and gave the suspect an undetermined amount of U.S. currency. The suspect fled on foot towards Aquahart Road. The victim was not injured in the incident. Officers and K-9 unit searched the area, but were unable to locate the suspect.

Suspect: White male, 40-55 years old, 5'9" with a medium build, wearing a green hooded jacket, blue jeans, white shoes and white gloves.

ROBBERY

LINTHICUM

On June 6, 2009, at approximately 1:48 p.m., officers from Northern District responded to High's Dairy Store located in the 400 block of Camp Meade Road S. in Linthicum for a report of an armed robbery.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with the store clerk, who advised that a male subject entered the store and announced a robbery. The clerk indicated that the subject displayed a black handgun and demanded U.S. currency. The clerk complied with the subject's demands and turned over an undisclosed amount of money. The suspect subsequently fled the store in an unknown direction. Several officers and a K-9 unit canvassed the area searched the area, but were unable to locate the suspect. There were no reported injuries.

Suspect: White male, 5'10" – 6'0", with short brown hair and facial hair, wearing a grey Sweater, blue jeans, blue, baseball cap and sunglasses.
