NORTHERN DISTRICT

ROBBERY

GLEN BURNIE

On June 9, 2009, at approximately 10:48 p.m., officers from the Northern District responded to the 1400 block of Houghton Road in Glen Burnie for a reported robbery.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with a male employee of the Pizza Raven, who stated that a male subject ordered a pizza from the business. When the driver approached the address, he was assaulted by a male suspect, who struck him and knocked him to the ground. While on the ground, several other male suspects approached and began to strike the victim. The suspects demanded money from the victim and he complied by handing over an undisclosed amount of U.S. currency and the pizza. The suspects then fled the area towards Saunders Way. Numerous officers, a K-9 unit and an Aviation unit searched the area, but could not find the suspects.

Suspect #1: White male with a beard in his late 20's, wearing a dark hoodie and pants

Suspect #2: Black male with a goatee, skinny build and wearing a hoodie

ROBBERY

GLEN BURNIE

On June 9, 2009, at approximately 6:35 p.m., officers from the Northern District responded to the Hollywood Video store located in the 7700 block of Ritchie Highway in Glen Burnie for a reported robbery.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with a female employee of the store, who stated that an unknown male subject entered the business, displayed a knife and threatened to throw acid on her if she did not give him the money from the cash register. The employee complied and handed over an undisclosed amount of U.S. currency. The suspect fled the store out the front towards the rear of the building. Several officers searched the vicinity, but were unable to locate the suspect.

Suspect: White male, 35 to 40 years old with a Ravens tattoo on right shoulder, mustache / goatee, medium to light brown, greasy light brown hair with specks of gray and observed wearing a black shirt and blue shorts.

On June 10, 2009, at approximately 12:08 a.m., officers from the Northern District responded to the area of E. Furnace Branch Road and E. Thompson Avenue in Glen Burnie for a report of a robbery.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with victims, who advised that they were in their basement apartment when a male suspect entered through a sliding glass door. The suspect displayed a black handgun and ordered the victims into a back bedroom. The suspect then demanded money and fled the scene in a large, older model, brown vehicle. A short time later, the vehicle was located and the driver was identified as the suspect. A black, pellet pistol that matched the description of the weapon used in the robbery was recovered. The suspect was arrested and charged at the Northern District Station.

ROBBERY

SEVERN

On June 9, 2009, at approximately 2:18 p.m., officers from the Western District responded to the 8500 block of Pioneer Drive in Severn for a report of an attempted robbery that occurred in this area.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with the male victim, who stated that he was in the area when three male subjects approached him in a threatening manner and demanded that he turn over his cellular telephone. The victim refused the demands and the suspects subsequently fled on foot behind residential buildings towards Jacobs Road. Numerous officers searched the area, but were unable to locate the suspects.

Suspects: Three black males in their teens, all approximately 5'10', 175-180 pounds with medium builds. One suspect was shirtless and the others were possibly wearing jeans and t-shirts.

SOUTHERN DISTRICT

DWI/CDS ARRESTS

DEALE

On June 11, 2009, at approximately 1:49 a.m., officers from the Southern District observed a vehicle turn off its lights as it pulled onto the lot of the Central Sod Farm located on Swamp Circle Road in Deale.

Officers responded to check the vehicle as the business was closed. Officers made contact with the operator of the vehicle, who was placed under arrest for driving while intoxicated. During a search of the vehicle, officers recovered marijuana on the floorboard behind the passenger seat of the vehicle. The two passengers were placed under arrest and a large quantity of marijuana (115 grams), a scale and several small glassine bags were located in a shoebox behind the front passenger seat. A search of one of the passengers revealed that he was in possession of \$2118 in cash, 5 grams of marijuana and 8.1 grams of cocaine.

All the suspects were charged with possession of CDS, possession with intent to distribute and possession of paraphernalia. Officers seized a total of \$2458.00 in cash, marijuana valued at \$1150.00, cocaine valued at \$800.00. The total CDS street value was \$1950.00. A 1994 Isuzu Trooper was also seized for forfeiture.
