ROBBERY

GLEN BURNIE

On June 12, 2009, at approximately 10:49 a.m., officers from Northern District responded to the EZ Storage located in the 6700 block of Ritchie Highway in Glen Burnie for a report of a robbery.

Upon arrival, officers spoke to an employee, who advised that a male subject entered the business, displayed a black handgun and demanded money. The employee complied with the suspect's demands and handed over an undetermined amount of U.S. currency. The suspect then fled the area on foot towards the back of the business. Numerous officers and a K-9 unit searched the area, but were unable to locate the suspect.

Suspect: Black male, approximately 6'0" with a thin build, wearing a black hoodie, black pants, black shoes, black gloves and a black and white bandana covering some of his face.

STABBING

BROOKLYN PARK

On June 13, 2009, at approximately 10:24 p.m., officers from the Northern District responded to the Brooklyn Park Youth Athletic Association Park located in the 300 block of 10th Avenue in Brooklyn Park for a reported stabbing.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with the three male victims from Columbia and several witnesses, who stated that a physical altercation had occurred between the victims and the suspects at the conclusion of a game they were watching. During the fight, the suspects removed

pocket knives and stabbed the victims. The suspects then fled the area on foot. Two of the victims suffered lacerations to the legs and one suffered a laceration to the abdomen. All three were transported to Shock Trauma in stable condition with non-life threatening injuries and have since been released. Several officers and a K-9 unit canvassed the area and could not locate the suspects. Suspect #1: Hispanic male, approximately 25-30 years old, long shoulder length hair, last seen wearing a white tank top and jean shorts

Suspect #2: Hispanic male, approximately 30-40 years old, approximately 6'0" with a medium build, long hair, had a lazy left eye, goatee, gapped teeth, last seen wearing a white t-shirt and long, white shorts

Suspect #3: Hispanic male, approximately 25-30 years old, short hair, last seen wearing a white shirt

Suspect #4: Hispanic male, approximately 25-30 years old, short hair, last seen wearing a white shirt
