ROBBERY ARREST

GLEN BURNIE

On June 16, 2009, at approximately 12:00 a.m., officers from Northern District responded to the 7300 block of Baltimore and Annapolis Boulevard in Glen Burnie for a report of a robbery and assault that just occurred.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with the victim, a 23-year-old male, who indicated that he was approached and assaulted by four males at that location. During the assault, the suspects took an undetermined amount of money from the victim. Officers searched the area and located two juvenile suspects that were identified as being involved in this robbery. The two juvenile suspects were subsequently taken into custody and charged in the incident. The victim indicated that two other male juveniles were also involved in this robbery and they remain at large at this time. The victim sustained a large contusion near his left eye, but declined any medical attention.

Suspect #1: 15-year-old male from Glen Burnie. He was charged with Robbery, 2nd Degree Assault and Theft.

Suspect #2: 16-year-old male from Baltimore. He was charged with Robbery, 2nd Degree Assault and Theft.

Suspect #3: Black male, approximately 15-16 years old, wearing dark clothing

Suspect #4: Black male, approximately 15-16 years old, wearing dark clothing
