WESTERN DISTRICT

ASSAULT ARREST

MILLERSVILLE

On June 16, 2009, at approximately 3:56 a.m., officers from the Western District responded to a report of a shooting in the 8100 block of Windy Field Lane in Millersville.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with a male victim, who stated that he was attending a party when he became involved in a verbal dispute with a male subject outside of the residence. The victim stated the suspect produced what he believed to be a handgun, pointed it at him and threatened to shoot him. Next, the suspect discharged the gun into the ground and went back inside the residence. Officers were able to locate the suspect inside the residence and he was subsequently taken into custody. After a search of the residence, officers recovered a pellet gun modeled after a semiautomatic pistol. There were no injuries in the incident.

Suspect: John James Holmes, 22, of the 300 block of Whitman Court, Glen Burnie, MD 21061. He was charged with 1st Degree Assault, 2nd Degree Assault, Reckless Endangerment and Disorderly Conduct.

NORTHERN DISTRICT

ROBBERY

GLEN BURNIE

On June 16, 2009, at approximately 10:05 p.m., officers from the Northern District responded to the Papa Johns Pizza located in the 800 block of Crain Highway South in Glen Burnie for a report of a robbery.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with the manager, who stated that a male subject entered the business, pointed what appeared to be a sawed off shotgun at employees and demanded money from the cash register. The employees complied with the demands and the suspect obtained an undetermined amount of U.S. currency. The suspect then fled on foot toward the back of the business. Numerous officers and a K-9 unit searched the area, but were unable to locate the suspect. There were no injuries reported during the incident.

Suspect: Black male with a thin build, approximately 5'9", wearing all black clothing and a black bandana as a mask.
