ATTEMPTED ROBBERY ARRESTS

HANOVER

On June 23, 2009, at approximately 6:14 p.m., officers from the Western District responded to the 7000 block of Arundel Mills Circle in Hanover for a report of an attempted robbery.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with the victim, a 24-year-old female, who advised that she was walking away from the mall after shopping when she was approached by three female subjects and a male subject. All four suspects blocked her path and the male suspect punched her and attempted to grab her purse. The victim resisted and attempted to flee the area on foot, but was eventually tackled from behind by the suspects. She reported being struck by a board during the assault. As the suspects were attempting to remove her purse, a citizen observed the assault and subsequently yelled at the suspects. Consequently, all of the suspects fled on foot, yet were quickly apprehended by officers responding to the scene. The victim positively identified the three female suspects, who were arrested and charged with Attempted Robbery and 2nd Degree Assault. Additionally, the male suspect has been identified and charges may be pending at this time as he is still part of the investigation. The victim suffered minor injuries in the incident.

Synopsis:

On June 23, 2009, at approximately 4:19 p.m., members of the Traffic Safety Section responded to the area of Route 4 and Lower Pindell Road in Lothian for a multiple vehicle crash.

Preliminary investigation suggests that Samuel Barry Hall was operating a 1999 Ford F250 (vehicle #1) that was traveling westbound on Lower Pindell Road. The operator eventually crossed southbound Route 4 and collided with vehicle # 2, a 2010 Hyundai, being driven by Kevin Wayne Cornett. Vehicle # 1 traveled down an embankment into the woods approximately 75 feet from the road. Vehicle # 2 traveled approximately 65 feet on Lower Pindell Road, where it came to rest.

Paramedics transported Samuel Barry Hall to Prince George's Shock Trauma. Kevin Wayne Cornett was air lifted to Baltimore Shock Trauma with critical injuries. It appears both

drivers were wearing their seat belts at the time of the crash. The airbag deployed in the Hyundai and appeared to be in proper working order. Preliminary investigation does not suggest speed was a contributing factor in the crash. It is unknown if alcohol was a factor in the crash.
