NORTHERN DISTRICT

BURGLARY ARRESTS

BROOKLYN PARK/ LINTHICUM

During the months of May and June of this year, the areas of Brooklyn Park and Linthicum saw an increase in the number of residential burglaries. Many of these burglaries were similar in nature and method. Several investigators from the Northern District Detective Unit (DDU) were working on this case and were able to identify four suspects involved in several of these burglaries.

On June 22, 2009, at approximately 11:30 p.m., investigators, with the assistance of the Special Operations Section, executed a Search and Seizure Warrant at 742 Sunnyfield Lane in Baltimore. This address was identified by investigators as a location where suspected stolen property was being stored from the area burglaries. Investigators located and seized a significant amount of stolen property taken from several different burglaries. The property included several televisions, jewelry, various electronics, CD's, DVD's, coin collections and safes. To date, 14 area burglaries have been cleared from the property that was recovered from the search warrant and through other investigative methods. ROBBERY

LINTHICUM

On June 29, 2009, at approximately 11:07 a.m., officers from Northern District responded to the 400 block of Hillview Drive in Linthicum for a report of an assault that occurred earlier.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with the female victim, who advised that she was assaulted in the fenced dumpster area of Lynn Hill Apartments while throwing away her trash. During the assault, the suspect stole the victim's cell phone and then fled the area. The suspect was last seen walking toward Baltimore Annapolis Boulevard. Numerous officers canvassed the vicinity, but were unable to locate the suspect. The victim sustained minor injuries in the assault.

Suspect: Indian or Middle Eastern male, hazel eyes, white/black tank top shirt, blue jeans, white/gray shoes. He has a tattoo on his left forearm of a large knife and a tattoo on his right forearm that is tribal or lettered.

ROBBERY UPDATE

HANOVER

On June 23, 2009, at approximately 6:14 p.m., officers from the Western District responded to the 7000 block of Arundel Mills Circle in Hanover for a report of an attempted robbery.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with the victim, a 24-year-old female, who advised that she was walking away from the mall after shopping when she was approached by three female subjects and a male subject. All four suspects blocked her path and the male suspect punched her and attempted to grab her purse. The victim resisted and attempted to flee the area on foot, but was eventually tackled from behind by the suspects. She reported being struck by a board during the assault. As the suspects were attempting to remove her purse, a citizen observed the assault and subsequently yelled at the suspects. Consequently, all of the suspects fled on foot; and three

suspects were quickly apprehended by officers responding to the scene. The victim positively identified the three female suspects, who were arrested and charged.

UPDATE:

Through further investigation and interviews, the fourth suspect was identified as also being involved in the aforementioned robbery. The suspect was arrested and charged on June 29, 2009. The charges entailed Armed Robbery, First Degree Assault, Second Degree Assault and Reckless Endangerment.
