**Eastern District**

**Burglary Apprehension**

**Millersville**

On March 2, 2008, at approximately 0126 hours, Anne Arundel County Police Officers of the Eastern District were directed to the 8500 block of Veterans Highway in Millersville for a report of a burglary in progress. A security guard working at the construction site reported seeing several suspects running inside a building under construction.

Officers quickly established a perimeter and assisted K-9 with a search of the building. Subsequently, four juvenile males were located in the building and arrested. The four were charged with 4<sup>th</sup> degree burglary. The suspects were all seventeen years of age and were from Severna Park and Millersville. Nothing appeared to have been damaged or stolen from the construction site.

On March 2, 2008 at 2359 hours, Officers responded to TK Sharkey's located at 2072 Sommerville Road, Annapolis, Maryland 21401 for a report of an assault. Officer's contacted the victim, Leonel Romirez Guzman, who said two men assaulted him while he was inside the business. Mr. Guzman later identified the suspects as Anner J. Madrigal (w/m 05/18/87) and Gustavo G. Olan (w/m 09/20/86) of Annapolis, Maryland. Mr. Guzman was struck on the head with a beer bottle and stabbed in the back with a broken beer bottle. Mr. Guzman was transported to Anne Arundel Medical Center for non-life threatening injuries. The suspects were identified on scene and were arrested. **Both suspects were charged with First and Second Degree Assault.**

### Distribution of CDS

### Glen Burnie

In February 2008, members of the Northern District Tactical Narcotics Team along with the Northern District Tactical Patrol Unit conducted a CDS investigation. The investigation resulted in the execution of a search and seizure warrant and seizure orders for a 1997 Dodge Ram 1500 and a 2002 Pontiac Grand Prix.

Pursuant to the search and seizure warrant and the seizure orders for the two vehicles a traffic stop was performed at Route 10 South near Baltimore Annapolis Boulevard on the 2002 Pontiac Grand Prix. A search of the operator of the vehicle revealed and recovered approximately 26.41 grams of CDS crack-cocaine with a street value of \$2,641.00 and \$203.00 of US currency. The 1997 Dodge Ram 1500 was also seized from 533 West Hoffman Street Baltimore, MD 21217 with the assistance of Baltimore City Police Department.

**Robbery****Glen Burnie**

On February 29, 2008 at approximately 18:37 hours, officers responded to the Dollar General, located at 7943 B & A Blvd, Glen Burnie , Anne Arundel County, MD for the report of a robbery. Upon arrival, officers located the victim who advised that she removed money from her purse and held it in her hand preparing to pay for her merchandise. The suspect then approached her from behind and grabbed her wrist forcing her to let go of the money. The suspect then fled the business on foot towards Cedarcliff Drive. Several officers along with the K9 unit canvassed the area with negative results.

Suspect: Black male, approximately 5-8 to 5-10, medium build, last seen wearing a blue hat, dark colored jacket, possibly blue and dark colored pants

**Robbery****Glen Burnie**

On February 29, 2008 at approximately 1530hrs, Officers responded to the Bank of America located at 80 Mountain Rd. Glen Burnie Md. 21061 for a report of robbery that just occurred. Upon arrival, officers spoke with the bank manager who stated that a thin white male in his late 20's or early 30's entered the bank, and handed a note to a teller demanding money. An unknown amount of U.S. Currency was handed to the suspect who then fled on foot towards Rt.10. Officers and K9 responded to the scene and canvassed the area, with negative results.

Suspect: White male, thin build, late 20's to early 30's, approx. 6'0'' tall, brown or blonde hair (wavy on top), blue jacket, blue jeans.
