SOUTHERN DISTRICT

ARMED ROBBERY

ANNAPOLIS (PAROLE)

On March 24, 2008, at 10:58 PM., units from the Southern District responded for a report of a Robbery that just occurred at Today's Pizza, located at 2058 Somerville Rd in Annapolis. According to one of the employees a black male entered the store and displayed a handgun and said, "don't move." The employee immediately ran behind one of the pizza ovens. The black male went behind the counter and took an undetermined amount of US Currency from the cash register and fled the store out the front door. One of the drivers for the business was getting out of his vehicle when the black male approached him and told him to get back in his car and give the suspect a ride. The black male then got into the passenger side of the vehicle and told the driver to take him across Solomon's Island Road behind the Shoppers Food Warehouse. The black male then told the driver to stop and got out of the vehicle and fled on foot. Southern District units arrived in the area along with K-9 and Air canvassing the area with negative results. The suspect was described as a black male approximately 6' tall having a thin build, last seen wearing a ski mask, gray hooded sweatshirt and black pants.

NORTHERN DISTRICT

ARMED ROBBERY

On March 24th, 2008, at approx. 11:50 PM., three black males entered the Pizza Boli's located at 300 North Crain Hwy. While in the business one of the males produced a black semi-automatic handgun, and demanded money from the cash register. After obtaining an undisclosed amount of U.S. Currency, the armed suspect then dragged the employee outside, and then took an undisclosed amount of U.S. Currency from the employee's wallet. The suspects then fled on foot going westbound from the business. An area canvass was conducted and a lookout was broadcasted both of which had negative results.

Suspect #1- black male, 25-27, 6'0. 200lbs., all dark clothing, double left ear piercing, armed with handgun

Suspect#2- black male, 25-27, 6'0, 200lbs., Bright red shirt

Suspect#3- black male, 25-27, 6'0, 200lbs., Green army jacket
