On March 26th 2008 at 1032 hours officers from the Northern District spoke with a victim who reported that a white male suspect approached him at the CVS Pharmacy, located at 7095 Baltimore Annapolis Blvd. and produced a silver handgun. The suspect demanded money from the victim. The victim and suspect had a brief struggle and the suspect fled on foot and left the scene in a white Chevy Trailblazer, with an unknown driver. A lookout was broadcasted and the vehicle was located and stopped on Ritchie Highway near Americana Circle. Officers arrested the suspect and the driver. The victim and a witness identified one of the vehicle's occupants as being the one who committed the crime. A silver toy handgun was found on the passenger's seat of the vehicle. The adult suspects have been identified as:

Russell Charles Wilkins, White/Male, 728 Griffith Lane, Glen Burnie, Maryland 21060.
Charged with robbery, armed robbery, and 1st and 2nd degree assault.

Kathryn Shannon Durden, White/Female, 724 Elmhurst Station Road, Severn, Maryland 21144.

Charged with robbery and accessory after the fact of the robbery.

THEFT FROM AUTO

On 03-27-2008 at approximately 1255 AM, officers responded to the area of 360 Gatewater Ct. Glen Burnie MD 21060 in reference to three white male juveniles tampering with vehicles. Upon arrival, officers located three white male juveniles wearing all dark clothing standing near a white Infinity Q45.

The officer's investigation revealed that the white Infinity had been tampered with and U.S. Currency, a wallet, and several compact discs were stolen from within. The missing contents from the vehicle were located on the juveniles and on the ground nearby. One juvenile was in possession of marijuana.

All three juveniles were transported to Northern District and charged with theft less than \$500 and rogue and vagabond. In addition, one juvenile was charged with possession of marijuana. The three juveniles were released to their parents. The suspect's ages range from 14 to 17 years old.
