WESTERN

ARMED ROBBERY

LAUREL

On March 27, 2008 at 1256 hrs, officers were dispatched to the PNC Bank located at 3386 Laurel Ft. Meade Road in Laurel, for a report of an armed robbery that just occurred. The suspect was described as a white male, approx. 6', 160 lbs, last seen wearing a dark blue hat, black ski mask, sunglasses, green shirt, and blue jeans. The suspect walked into the bank through the front door, pointed a small black handgun with red tape on the handle. He held a red Macy's shopping bag to the window and stated, "Give me the money". The bag was filled with an undetermined amount of cash, including the dye pack. The suspect then fled on foot out of the front door of the bank.

Officers supported by the Air Unit and K-9 searched for the suspect with negative results. No injuries were reported and the suspect stole an undetermined amount of currency.

SOUTHERN

BURGLARY ARREST

On March 28, 2008 at approximately 2200 hours, Southern District's P.A.C.T. Unit, with the assistance of the Prince George's County Police Department conducted a check of 12225 Van Brady Road in Upper Marlboro, Maryland. This was in reference to several recent burglaries and thefts that have occurred to a historical residence located at 670 Polling House Road in Harwood, Maryland. This

check was the result of several weeks of investigation by the Southern District Detective and P.A.C.T. unit along with information provided by several citizens.

While checking the property at this location, the suspect of the investigation was located hiding beneath a vehicle located on the premises. David Brian Halsey (white male, date of birth 05/10/65) of no fixed address was taken into custody without incident and transported to Anne Arundel County for charging. Detectives from Southern District's PACT unit and District Detective unit conducted a search of the premises and located several pieces of evidence linking Mr. Halsey to a burglary. Mr. Halsey was charged with the following:

- 4 counts Theft Over \$500
- 4 counts 2nd Degree Burglary
- 1 count Theft Scheme Over \$500
- 1 Count Destruction of Property Over \$500
- 1 Count Possession of Stolen Vehicle Tags

Mr. Halsey is also being questioned in relation to several other burglaries and thefts in the area, as well as in surrounding jurisdictions. These investigations are ongoing.
