**IDENTITY THEFT SCHEME**

On May 1<sup>st</sup> 2008 at approximately 1544 hours Officers from Northern District arrested three suspects at Marley Station mall involved in an interstate identity theft scheme. The suspects stole the identity of victims from the Internet, established false credit accounts, and purchased items utilizing the fraudulent accounts. The items were then sold to Internet customers. The suspects were charged with multiple theft and fraud charges listing multiple victims. The amount of the merchandise theft in Anne Arundel County was preliminarily established at over \$5,000. Over \$6,000 in American Currency was recovered as evidence. Baltimore County Police is currently seeking charges for thefts related to this case. Evidence recovered from the suspects revealed an organized interstate theft scheme.

Both males were arrested and charged with strong-arm robbery and theft less than \$100.
