The event, SHRED-A-RAMA III, will be held at the following four locations: Brooklyn Park Middle School at 200 Hammonds Lane in Baltimore, Md., Cancun Cantina at 7501 Old Telegraph Road in Hanover, Md., South River High School at 200 Central Avenue East in Edgewater, Md. and Anne Arundel County Police Headquarters at 8495 Veterans Highway in Millersville, Md.

Any resident of Anne Arundel County may bring up to four handheld boxes of personal documents for shredding in a commercial shredder. This is an ideal opportunity for residents to safely dispose of old tax and medical records, financial documents and other personal items to help prevent identity theft. Please remember to remove documents from binders and remove any metal clips. Additionally, x-rays, film and CDs will not be shredded.
