**NORTHERN DISTRICT**

**BANK ROBBERY**

**GLEN BURNIE**

On May 6, 2009, at approximately 9:56 a.m., officers from the Northern District responded to the SunTrust Bank located at 7750 Ritchie Highway in Glen Burnie for a report of a bank robbery.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with a female employee, who advised that a male suspect entered the bank and passed her a handwritten note indicating that he wanted her to hand over money from the teller drawers or someone would get hurt. A weapon was never displayed, but the employee heard a metal sound banging against the counter that was coming from beneath the clothing of the suspect. The employee complied and gave the suspect an undetermined amount of U.S. currency. There were no injuries reported in the incident. The suspect fled the scene on foot heading west behind Harundale Plaza. Numerous officers searched the area for the suspect, but were unable to locate the individual.

**Suspect: Black male in his mid 20's with a slight mustache, approximately 5'05" – 5'07", 150 – 160 lbs. He was last observed wearing a brown, baseball hat, brown, hoodie with a zipper and white spots and blue jeans.**

## GLEN BURNIE

On May 6, 2009, at approximately 6:40 p.m., officers from the Northern District's Tactical Patrol Unit (TPU) were patrolling the Ritchie Highway corridor in Glen Burnie when detectives observed a male subject standing in the area of Ritchie Highway and Welham Avenue in Glen Burnie. The subject was observed possessing an open container of an alcoholic beverage while standing at this location.

Upon further investigation, the subject was arrested for possession of an open container of alcohol. Subsequent to his arrest, TPU detectives also recovered 32 individual baggies of suspected heroin from the suspect. The suspected heroin was packaged for sale. The total weight of the suspected heroin was approximately 2.17 grams with a street value of approximately \$217.00.

**Suspect: Sean Joseph Humphery, 36, of 2020 North Pulaski Street, Baltimore, Md, 21217. He was charged with Possession of an Open Container of Alcohol on a Public Road, Possession of Heroin, Possession With Intent to Distribute Heroin and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.**

## ROBBERY

## GAMBRILLS

On May 7, 2009, at approximately 12:20 a.m., officers from the Western District responded to the 7-11 Store located at 1044 Route 3 North in Gambrills for a report of an armed robbery.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with the clerk, who stated that a male subject entered the store and used a handgun to gesture for her to get behind the counter. The suspect then pulled out a small black bag, gave it to her and forced her to fill the bag with several cartons of cigarettes. The suspect then grabbed an unknown amount of single pack cigarettes and stuffed them in the bag as well. Additionally, he told the clerk to give him money and she complied by opening the cash register and placing an undetermined amount of U.S. currency into the bag. The suspect

subsequently grabbed the bag from the clerk and walked out of the store. Numerous officers and a K-9 unit canvassed the area, but were unable to locate the suspect.

**Suspect: Black male, approximately 5'9", 175 lbs. Last seen wearing a black sweatshirt, light blue jeans, black stockings over his head and face, black gloves and armed with a handgun.**
