ROBBERY

GLEN BURNIE

On May 11, 2009, at approximately 7:33 p.m., officers from Eastern District responded to the Pacifico Restaurant in the 7700 block of Quarterfield Road in Glen Burnie for a report of a robbery.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with the business owner, who advised that the suspect entered the store, displayed a black and brown handgun and demanded money. The suspect received an unknown amount of U.S. currency and fled on foot towards the rear of the building. Numerous officers searched the area, but were unable to locate the suspect. There were no reported injuries in the incident.

Suspect: Black male, approximately 5'10"-6'0", 170 pounds with a thin build, short dark hair, wearing a black t-shirt, blue jeans and a black bandana covering the lower portion of his face.

ROBBERY

On May 11, 2009, at approximately 10:47 p.m., officers from the Western District responded to the Highs Dairy Store in the 7800 block of Parke West Drive for a report of a robbery.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with the victim, a 22-year-old male clerk, who stated that a male subject entered the store, placed a bag on the ground and told the clerk to fill the bag with

cigarettes and money from the cash register. While the clerk was filling the bag, the suspect also placed several Maryland Lottery tickets into the bag. The suspect then fled the store in an unknown direction. There was no weapon used or implied in the incident and no report of injuries. Numerous officers and a K-9 unit canvassed the area, but were unable to locate the suspect.

Suspect: Black male, approximately 5'7"-5'9", wearing a black, hooded sweatshirt, a black, baseball hat turned backwards and large sunglasses.
