WESTERN DISTRICT

ROBBERY

SEVERN

On May 12, 2009, at approximately 10:20 p.m., officers from the Western District responded to a report of an armed robbery of a citizen and met the victim at the Severn Square Shopping Center in the 2600 block Annapolis Road in Severn.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with the 20-year-old male victim, who advised that he was walking on Disney Road at Severn Tree Road when he observed a vehicle drive by him on Disney Road. The vehicle suddenly made a U-turn, drove towards him and stopped. A male subject on the front, passenger side exited the vehicle, approached the victim and pointed a handgun at the victim. The driver of the vehicle also exited the vehicle and stood next to the vehicle as the first suspect ordered the victim to hand over his belongings. The victim complied and handed the suspect his backpack. Both suspects got back into the vehicle and fled on Disney Road towards MD 175 (Annapolis Road). There were no reported injuries in the incident. Officers searched the area, but were unable to locate the suspects.

Suspect #1: Male, 5'10", 165 lbs., wearing a full facemask black hooded sweatshirt and black pants

Suspect #2: Male, 5'8", wearing dark clothing

ROBBERY

GLEN BURNIE

On May 12, 2009, at approximately 11:35 p.m., officers from the Northern District responded to the Video Outlet in the 800 block of Crain Highway in Glen Burnie for a report of a robbery.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with the store clerk, who advised that he was working the register of the business as two subjects entered the business from the rear door. One of the suspects was armed with a shotgun and both suspects ordered the clerk to open the register. The clerk complied and the suspects took an undetermined amount of U.S. currency from the business. The suspects were last seen exiting the rear of the business on foot. There were no injuries reported in the incident. Numerous officers, an Aviation unit and a K-9 unit canvassed the area for the suspects, but were unable to locate them.

Suspect #1: Black male in his 20's, 6'4" to 6'5" with a medium build, wearing a black hoodie, black ski mask, blue jeans with white markings on the rear pockets, white under shirt, blue jeans and white shoes.

Suspect #2: Black male in his late teens to early 20's, approximately 6'0" with a thin build, wearing a blue, zip up hoodie, blue bandana on his face, blue ski hat, black pants and dark shoes
