Synopsis:

On May 14, 2009, at approximately 4:37 p.m., officers from the Southern District were dispatched to the area of Southern Maryland Blvd and Bay Front Road in Lothian for a serious crash. Due to the severity of the crash, Traffic Safety Section crash investigators were dispatched to assume responsibility for the investigation.

The initial investigation revealed that the crash occurred at the ramp for Bay Front Road from Southern Maryland Blvd. The operator of the vehicle, Kevin Wayne Stubbs, was traveling northbound on Southern Maryland Blvd when he left the roadway for an unknown reason and struck a tree head-on. Mr. Stubbs was flown by Maryland State Police Helicopter to University of Maryland Shock Trauma in critical condition. The investigation into the cause of the crash continues.

EASTERN DISTRICT**ROBBERY****GLEN BURNIE**

On May 15, 2009, at approximately 3:30 a.m., officers from the Eastern District responded to the Exxon in the 8000 block of Crain Hwy in Glen Burnie for a report of an unknown disturbance.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with the clerk, who stated that an unknown male subject entered the store and immediately ran over to the counter and sprayed him in the face with pepper spray. The suspect then grabbed a case of lottery tickets and an unknown amount of cigars before leaving the store. The clerk was unable to give any further description of the suspect or determine if the suspect left on foot or in a vehicle. Numerous officers and a K-9 unit canvassed the area, but were unable to locate the suspect. The clerk refused medical attention at this time.
