SOUTH CAROLINA MURDER INVESTIGATION ARRESTS

GLEN BURNIE

On May 18, 2009, the Anne Arundel County Police Department received a request for assistance from the Williamsburg County, South Carolina Sheriff's Department in reference to locating suspects wanted for a murder that occurred in their jurisdiction.

Officers and detectives from the Eastern District and the Special Enforcement Team began surveillance of an apartment in the 400 block of Pamela Road in Glen Burnie, where the suspects were believed to be living. A short time later, two male subjects were observed leaving the apartment. They were detained, identified and subsequently arrested in reference to the South Carolina case. The 17-year-old suspect's mother was located at her place of employment in Howard County and was arrested by the Howard County Police Department.

At the request of the Williamsburg County Sheriff's Department, Anne Arundel County Police Department Homicide Unit detectives obtained a Search and Seizure Warrant for the suspect's apartment and a vehicle they had been operating. Evidence was recovered and is being held for the Williamsburg County Sheriff's Department.

Suspect #1: Ronald H. Mack (charged as an adult), 17, of the 400 block Pamela Road, Glen Burnie, MD 21061. Charged as a fugitive, currently being held at the Anne Arundel County Detention Center pending extradition to South Carolina.

Suspect #2: Twanda M. Allen, 36, of the 400 block of Pamela Road, Glen Burnie, MD 21061. Charged as a fugitive, currently being held at the Howard County Detention Center pending extradition to South Carolina.

Suspect #3: Kelvin M. Bowen Jr., 31, of the 400 block of Pamela Road, Glen Burnie, MD 21061. Charged as a fugitive, currently being held at the Anne Arundel County Detention Center pending extradition to South Carolina.
