ROBBERY

GLEN BURNIE

On May 18, 2009, at approximately 10:18 p.m., officers from Northern District responded to the Clauss Liquors in the 600 block of Crain Highway in Glen Burnie for a report of a robbery.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with the cashier, who advised that the suspect entered the store, displayed a handgun and demanded money after he approached the counter. Next, the suspect walked behind the counter, where the cashier complied with his demands and handed over an undisclosed amount of U.S. currency from the drawer before leaving the scene. Numerous officers searched the area, but were unable to locate the suspect.

Suspect: Black male, 6'0", 180-200 lbs, wearing a green hoodie, black jeans, gloves and a scarf over his face.

STOLEN AUTO ARREST

On May 19, 2009, at approximately 1:44 a.m., officers were conducting radar in the area of Generals Highway and Sunrise Beach in Crownsville when a silver Honda Civic was traveling southbound on Generals Highway in excess of the posted speed limit.

After conducting a traffic stop, the vehicle operator and passenger exited the vehicle and fled on foot from the scene. Several officers and a K-9 unit responded and canvassed the area. The vehicle operator was located and investigation revealed the vehicle was stolen. Additionally, officers were able to link this investigation to two other stolen auto cases. The investigation is still being conducted to identify the passenger. The suspect was detained and placed under arrest. The

suspect, **Anthony Francis Palmieri**, 20, of the 500 block of Oakton Road in Odenton, was charged with Theft over \$500, Unlawful Taking of a Motor Vehicle and Unauthorized Use of a Motor Vehicle, Speeding and Fleeing the Police on Foot.
