**WESTERN DISTRICT**

**ROBBERY**

**SEVERN**

On May 21, 2009, at approximately 8:36 a.m., officers from the Western District responded to the Ye Old Farm Spirit Shop located in the 2600 block of Annapolis Road in Severn for a report of a robbery.

Upon arrival, officers spoke to the victim, who advised that he was moving merchandise into a storage area in the rear of the store when he noticed that one box of merchandise was missing. The victim observed several juveniles nearby and one was actually carrying the stolen merchandise. Consequently, the victim approached the juveniles and detained one.

At that point, several other juveniles surrounded the victim, assaulted the victim and fled the area on foot with the stolen merchandise. Numerous officers responded to search the area and four individuals matching the descriptions of the suspects were located and detained in the area of Trafalgar Court in Severn. The victim was brought to the location that the suspects were being detained and he positively identified all four subjects as the individuals who robbed him. All four suspects were transported to Western District Station, where they were charged as juveniles with robbery. The merchandise was recovered and returned to the store and the victim was not injured in the incident.

**Suspects: Two 16-year-old juvenile males from Severn, a 16-year-old juvenile male from Hanover and a 15-year-old juvenile male from Hanover.**

### **CDS ARREST**

### **DAVIDSONVILLE**

On May 22, 2009, at approximately 12:21 a.m., officers from Southern conducted a traffic stop at the intersection of Route 214 and Queen Anne Bridge Road in Davidsonville.

Upon checking with the driver, he was taken into custody for driving while under the influence of alcohol. A further search revealed that the suspect was in possession of suspected "crack cocaine" and marijuana. The total amount of drugs seized has a street value of \$ 3,853.00. In addition, \$1,507.00 in U.S. currency was seized from the suspect.

**Suspect: Thaddeus Maylord Thauls, 33, of 1917 Copeland Street, Annapolis, MD is being charged with Possession of CDS: Cocaine and Marijuana, Possession of Paraphernalia, DUI and assorted traffic offenses.**

### **GLEN BURNIE**

On May 22, 2009, at approximately 5:56 a.m., officers from the Northern District responded to the Cab Connection in the 7400 block of Furnace Branch Road in Glen Burnie for a report of an armed robbery that occurred earlier at the Twin Cove Apartments in the 100 block of Hammerlee Road in Glen Burnie.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with the taxi driver, who advised that she responded to an apartment complex in Glen Burnie for a taxi fare. Once she arrived, a male subject enter the cab, placed a black mask over his face and placed a black, semi-automatic handgun into her back while demanding her money and cell phone. The employee complied with the demands of the suspect, who fled the area on foot. Numerous officers searched the vicinity, but were unable to locate the suspect.

**Suspect: White male in his late 20's to early 30's, 5'5", 5'7", 150-160 lbs, brown hair, beard and sideburns, wearing a long sleeve black shirt and blue jeans.**
