ROBBERY

GLEN BURNIE

On May 20, 2009, at approximately 11:58 p.m., officers from Northern District responded to the 7-Eleven store in the 7000 block of Ritchie Highway in Glen Burnie for a report of a robbery.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with the store clerk, who advised that a male subject entered the store and attempted to purchase a soda when he pulled out a knife and demanded money. The clerk complied and handed the suspect an undetermined amount of U.S. currency. The suspect then fled the store and was last observed heading towards Crain Highway.
