ROBBERY

SEVERN

On May 28, 2009, at approximately 6:00 p.m., officers from Western District responded to Manet Way in Severn for a report of a robbery.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with the victim, a 14- year-old male, who stated that he was walking in the area of Meade Village Park when he was assaulted by two male subjects. During the assault, one suspect grabbed a pair of headphones from the victim and both suspects ran off toward a wooded path that leads from Meade Village. Numerous officers canvassed the area for the suspects, but were unable to locate them.

Suspect #1: Black male, 16-17 years old, 6'0" tall, thin build, dark skin, dread-lock style hair, gray and white striped long sleeve shirt, light colored jeans and gray, white and black Nike sneakers

Suspect #2: Black male, 16-17 years old, 6'0" tall, muscular build, dark skin, short hair, white T-shirt, black mesh shorts and black sneakers

On May 29, 2009, at approximately 3:45 a.m., officers from the Southern District observed a male subject operating a Ford truck on Mount Zion Marlboro Road near Sands Road in Lothian.

Officers observed the male suspect pulled into several driveways and a subsequent check of the vehicle registration indicated that it was not registered to anyone living at those addresses. Officers made contact with the suspect, who admitted to possessing drug paraphernalia. Furthermore, the suspect was found to be in possession of a large set of bolt cutters and crack cocaine. He was subsequently taken into custody and charged with Possession of CDS, Possession of CDS Paraphernalia and 4th Degree Burglary.
