**EASTERN DISTRICT DETECTIVES ARREST BURGLARY SUSPECTS**

**BURGLARY ARRESTS**

**PASADENA**

On November 4, 2009, at approximately 11:30 a.m., officers and detectives from the Eastern District responded to the 7900 block of River Walk Way in Pasadena for a report of a burglary in progress.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with eyewitness, who advised that two female subjects involved in the burglary fled to a residence in the 1300 block of Riverwood Way. Officers approached the suspect residence, located the suspects and placed them into custody without incident.

During a search of the residence, detectives located property that had been taken in the aforementioned burglary and property linking the suspects to other burglaries and theft from automobiles in the neighborhood. Additionally, drugs and drug paraphernalia were also located inside of the home. Both suspects were charged with 1<sup>st</sup> Degree Burglary, 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree Burglary, 4<sup>th</sup> Degree Burglary, Theft over \$1000 and Malicious Destruction to Property. Charges are also pending further investigation into other related burglaries, theft from automobile cases and narcotic violations.

## **WESTERN DISTRICT OFFICERS LOCATE AND ARREST ARMED ROBBERY SUSPECTS**

### **ARMED ROBBERY ARRESTS**

**HANOVER**

On November 5, 2009, at approximately 9:07 p.m., officers from Western District responded to a parking lot in the 7000 block of Arundel Mills Circle in Hanover for a report of a citizen robbery that just occurred.

Preliminary information provided by a dispatcher of Associated Cab Company indicated that one of their cab drivers was sitting in his vehicle when he was robbed. The victim was approached two male subjects, who displayed handguns and demanded money. The victim complied with their demands and gave the suspects an undetermined amount of money. The suspects then met up with a third suspect and fled on foot towards the Residence Inn.

A lookout was provided to responding units and officers canvassed the area for the suspects. Responding officers drove to the rear of the Residence Inn, where they located three subjects matching the description provided. The subjects were subsequently detained and positively identified as the individuals responsible for the robbery.

The suspects were arrested and transported to Western District. They were all charged with Armed Robbery, Robbery, 1st Degree Assault, 2nd Degree Assault and Theft Under \$100.

### **ROBBERY**

**SEVERN**

On November 5, 2009, at approximately 6:37 p.m., officers from Western District responded to the 8300 block of Candlewick Court in Severn for report of a citizen robbery that just occurred.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with two victims, a 17-year-old male and an 18-year-old male, who said that they were walking in the area of Pioneer Drive and Deerfield Drive when they were approached by several male subjects. The suspects struck both victims in the head and they fell to the ground. During the incident, one of the suspects took a cell phone from one of the victims. All of the suspects fled the area in an unknown direction. At this time, officers have identified two possible suspects and the investigation continues into the identity of other possible suspects.
