WESTERN DISTRICT

SHOOTING

SEVERN

On September 30, 2009, at approximately 11:30 p.m., officers from the Western District responded to the McDonald's located in the 800 block of Reece Road in Severn for a shooting that occurred earlier.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with the 30-year-old male victim, who advised that he and the 23-year-old female victim were parked in the 8200 block of Moneagan Court in Severn when three male subjects approached the vehicle. The three suspects then fired several rounds into the vehicle and struck the male victim. The female victim then drove the male victim to the McDonald's, where they contacted the police. The male victim was transported via ambulance to University of Maryland Shock Trauma and was treated for non-life threatening gunshot wounds. Numerous officers, a K-9 unit and an Aviation unit canvassed the area, but were unable to locate the suspects.

Suspect #1: Black male, wearing all dark clothing

Suspect #2: Black male, wearing all dark clothing and a ski mask

Suspect #3: Black male with dreadlocks, wearing all dark clothing, a ski mask and a tan hat

NORTHERN DISTRICT

STABBING

BROOKLYN PARK

On September 30, 2009, at approximately 2:30 p.m., officers from the Northern District responded to the 5000 block of Brookwood Road in Brooklyn Park for a report of a stabbing.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with the 15-year-old male victim, who advised that he had been stabbed earlier during a confrontation. The victim received stab wounds to his arm and leg and was transported to University of Maryland Shock Trauma to be treated for non-life threatening injuries. Numerous officers canvassed the area, but were unable to locate the suspect. At this time, through investigation, it is believed that the victim and the suspect are possibly known to each other and that this was not a random act of violence. Detectives have identified a possible suspect and the investigation is ongoing.
