ROBBERY

GLEN BURNIE

On October 8, 2009, at approximately 7:05 p.m., officers from the Eastern District responded to the Soda Pop shop located in the 300 block of Hospital Drive in Glen Burnie for a report of a robbery.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with two male employees, who advised that two male suspects entered the store, displayed handguns and demanded money. The victims complied with the demands and the suspects stole an undetermined amount of U.S. currency from the registers. The suspects fled through the front doors in an unknown direction and in an unknown vehicle. Neither of the victims was injured in the incident. Numerous officers and an Aviation unit searched the area, but were unable to locate the suspects.

Suspect #1: Black male, approximately 18-19 years old, wearing a white, long sleeve shirt, blue jeans, blue skull cap and a white bandana covering his face. (armed with a handgun)
Suspect #2: Black male with a heavy build, approximately 20-25 years old, wearing a black, long sleeve shirt, light blue jeans and a white shirt wrapped around his face. (armed with a handgun)
