**NORTHERN DISTRICT**

**Armed Robbery**

**Linthicum**

On October 9<sup>th</sup> at approximately 10:20 p.m., Northern District officers responded to the Kentucky Fried Chicken, located at 708 Nursery Road in Linthicum, for a reported armed robbery. Store employees advised that minutes before closing the dining area, two suspects entered the business with their shirts pulled up to cover their faces. They ordered the manager to open the safe. One suspect walked the manager to the safe while the other suspect went to the kitchen area, displayed a black revolver, and ordered the other employees to lie down on the floor. Both suspects grabbed an undisclosed amount of money from the safe, jumped over the counter, and ran from the store, dropping coins as they fled. The suspects were last seen on foot, running east across the parking lot. The area was checked by a canine unit and other officers, however, the suspects were not located.

**Suspect #1:** Black male, light complexion, mid to late teens, 5'7", thin build, wearing black gloves, and a green hooded sweatshirt. He was armed with a black revolver.

**Suspect #2:** Black male, light complexion, mid to late teens, 5'7", thin build, wearing black gloves, and a black hooded sweatshirt.

**WESTERN DISTRICT**

**Robbery**

**Laurel**

On October 10<sup>th</sup> at approximately 1:00 p.m., Western District officers responded to the 200 unit block of Ertter Drive, in Laurel for a robbery in a home. Officers spoke to the 26 year old, female victim, who advised two suspects entered the residence through an unlocked front door. The victim inside the home with three children, ages 4, 5, and 11. The first suspect

displayed a black handgun and the victim stated that she did not have any money. As that suspect held them at gunpoint, the second suspect made multiple trips in and out of the residence, removing electronic items. The victims were then ordered into a bedroom and the suspects fled the scene. After a few minutes, the victim contacted police. The suspects fled the area in a dark blue minivan or SUV, in an unknown direction.

**Suspect 1:** Black male, 19-22 years, 5'8", 170 lbs, green sweatshirt with a skull over chest, blue jeans, gray and black "G" sneakers, black bandana covering face, dark sun glasses, armed with a dark color handgun. Spoke with a Jamaican accent.

**Suspect 2:** Black male, light complexion, 19-22 years, 5'3" to 5'4", 160 lbs, light brown dreadlocks in a ponytail, black sweatshirt, black and white gloves, red bandana covering face with dark sun glasses.

### **EASTERN DISTRICT**

#### **Drug Arrest**

#### **Glen Burnie**

On October 11<sup>th</sup> at approximately 7:30 p.m., Eastern District officers responded to the area of Elvaton Court near Elvaton Road, in Glen Burnie, for a request to check an occupied vehicle. Upon arrival of the officers, four male occupants exited the vehicle, and three of them ran into the wooded area adjacent to the scene. The remaining occupant obeyed officers' commands, and returned to the vehicle. In a search of the immediate area in which the last subject stopped, officers found a baggie containing 23 glass vials, which contained suspected heroin. The suspects who fled from the scene have not been apprehended as of yet, and their identification is pending further investigation. The vehicle was seized, and the remaining suspect was charged as a juvenile. He was charged with Possession with Intent to Distribute CDS and Possession of CDS Paraphernalia.

**Suspect:** 16 year old male from Glen Burnie

### **SOUTHERN DISTRICT**

#### **Armed Robbery**

#### **Annapolis**

On October 10<sup>th</sup> at approximately 8:30 p.m., Southern District officers responded to Roosevelt Drive, in Annapolis, for a report of an armed robbery that just occurred. A 56 year old driver, for Yellow Checker Cab of Annapolis, had gone to the neighborhood for a fare. The victim reported that two male suspects approached him from both sides of his taxi, displayed weapons and took an undetermined amount of money, and his cell phone, before fleeing on foot. Canine and helicopter units responded to conduct a search with other officers, but the suspects were not located. Residents stated that they did not call for a taxi and no witnesses were located.

**Suspects:** Both described as black males, age 16-20, and wearing all black clothing. One was armed w/sawed off shotgun or rifle, and the other was armed with a black semiautomatic pistol.
