EASTERN DISTRICT

ARMED CARJACKING ARRESTS

PASADENA

On October 29, 2009, at approximately 1:27 a.m., officers from the Eastern District responded to the Brass Rail Saloon located in the 8100 block of Hog Neck Road in Pasadena for a report of an armed carjacking.

Through investigation, officers learned that several subjects followed the male victim from inside the bar out to the parking lot, surrounded his vehicle after he entered it and began physically assaulting him. Several suspects were armed with knives; however, the victim did not sustain injuries from the knives. One of the suspects jumped into the vehicle while it was running and fled the area and the other suspects left in two other vehicles.

A lookout was broadcast and multiple units canvassed the area to search for the suspects. One of the suspect vehicles was spotted on the lot of Willy D's bar on Fort Smallwood Road. Officers were directed inside and were told that several people had just run into the bar and that a few were hiding in a bathroom. Witnesses then told officers that two subjects had just left the lot in a black, Dodge pickup truck and were seen heading north on Fort Smallwood Road. A felony traffic stop was conducted on the vehicle and two suspects were detained. Positive identification was made and five suspects were eventually taken into custody. The victim's vehicle was also located on the side lot of Willy D's.

Four suspects were then charged with the following: Armed Carjacking, Armed Robbery, 1st Degree Assault, 2nd Degree Assault, Reckless Endangerment, Felony Theft, and Unauthorized Use of a Motor Vehicle.

On October 29, 2009, at approximately 12:51 a.m., officers from Northern District responded to the area of Freetown Road and Mountain Road in Glen Burnie for the report of a robbery.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with the male victim, who reported that he was approached by two male suspects while walking in the area. The suspects grabbed the victim, a struggle ensued and the suspects removed a bracelet and necklace and fled on foot towards the Freetown Community Complex. Numerous officers canvassed the area, but were unable to locate the suspects.

Suspect #1: Black male in his mid 20's, light skin with corn rows, wearing a grey sweatshirt and white athletic shoes

Suspect #2: Black male in his mid 20's, dark skin wearing a black hooded sweatshirt with orange writing, stocky build
