

❖ **60TH RECRUIT CLASS GRADUATION**

On October 3, 2002, the 60th Recruit Class of the Anne Arundel County Department began with 32 recruit officers. Thirty-one of the recruit officers were with the Anne Arundel County Police Department, and one recruit officer was with the Anne Arundel County Sheriff's Department. On April 2, 2003, twenty-two recruit officers graduated for the Anne Arundel County Police and one recruit officer graduated for the Anne Arundel County Sheriff's Office.

❖ **2003 SPRING IN-SERVICE PROGRAM**

Topics during the 2003 Spring In-Service program included a Domestic Violence Updates; Firearms (Care, Cleaning, Liability, and Day/Night Qualifications); First Responder; Officer Survival; Weapons of Mass Destruction (WMD); Project SAFE; Sex Crimes, and an Overview of Terrorism.
