PART TWO CRIME STATISTICS SUMMARY

Anne Arundel County citizens experienced a 0.5% *decrease* in the number of Part Two Crimes committed in 2005. There were 43,643 Part Two Crime incidents reported in 2005, compared to 43,861 Part Two crime incidents in 2004.

The most significant increase in Part Two Crimes were narcotics incidents with 150 incidents for a 4.6% increase over the previous year. Comparatively, other Part Two Crime incident increases included Prowlers increasing by 117. Leading the decreases in Part Two Crime incidents were disorderlies decreasing by 301; trespassing by 79; Liquor Violations by 77; and other criminal activities by 56.
