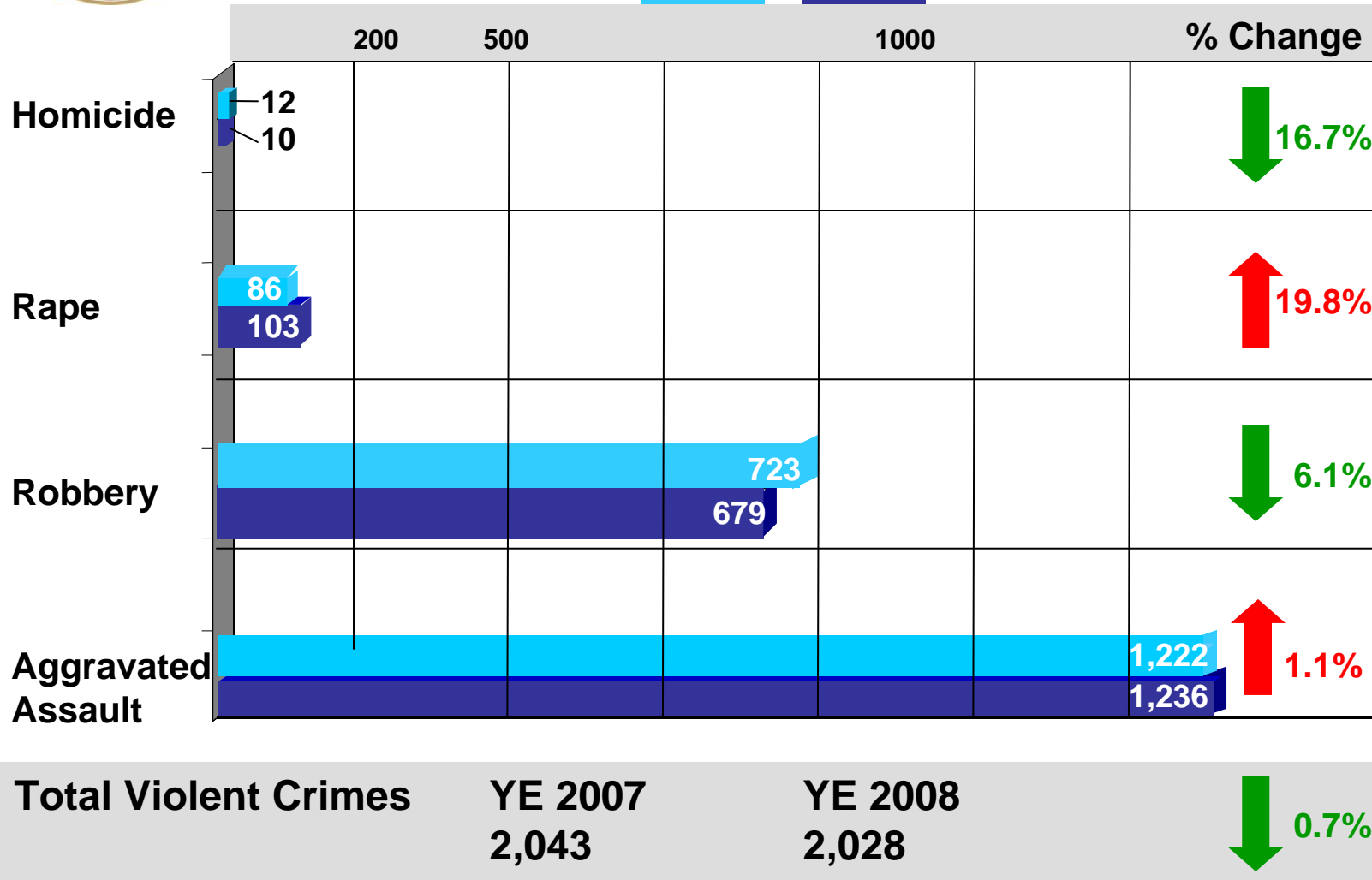

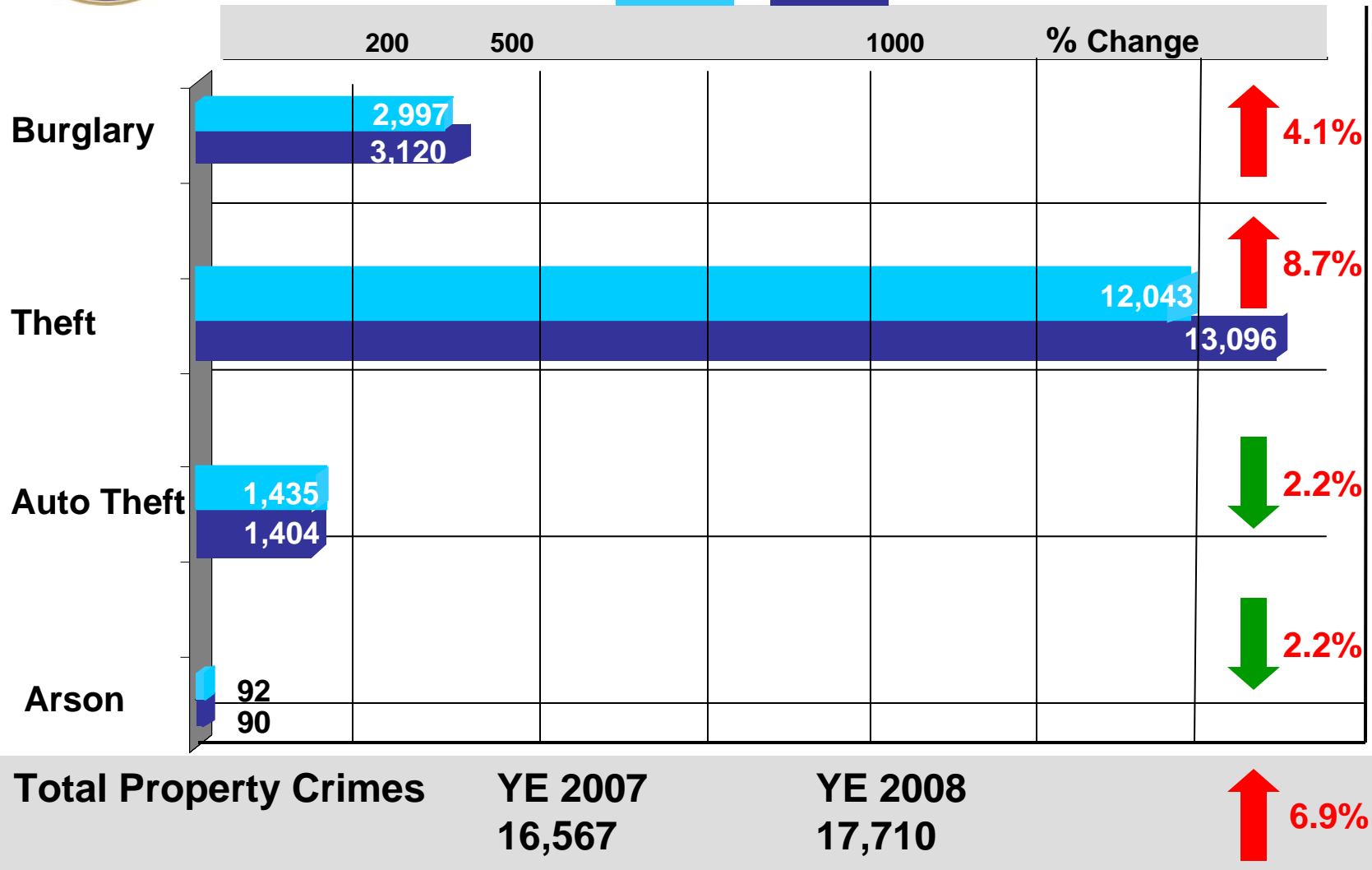

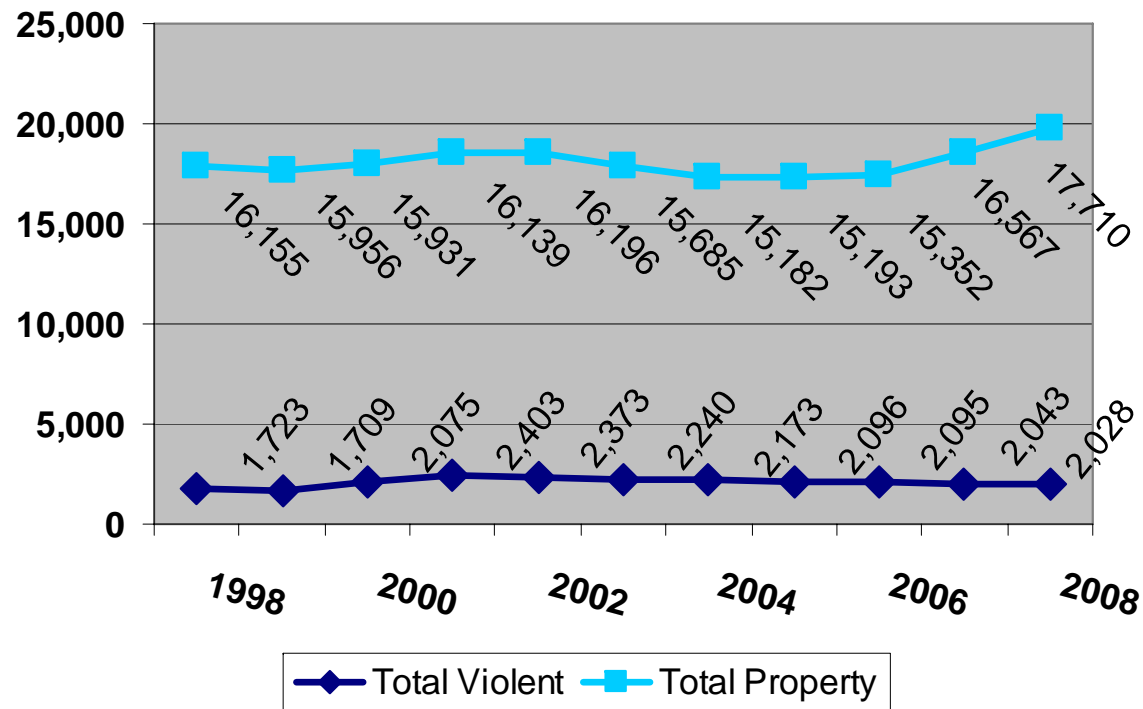

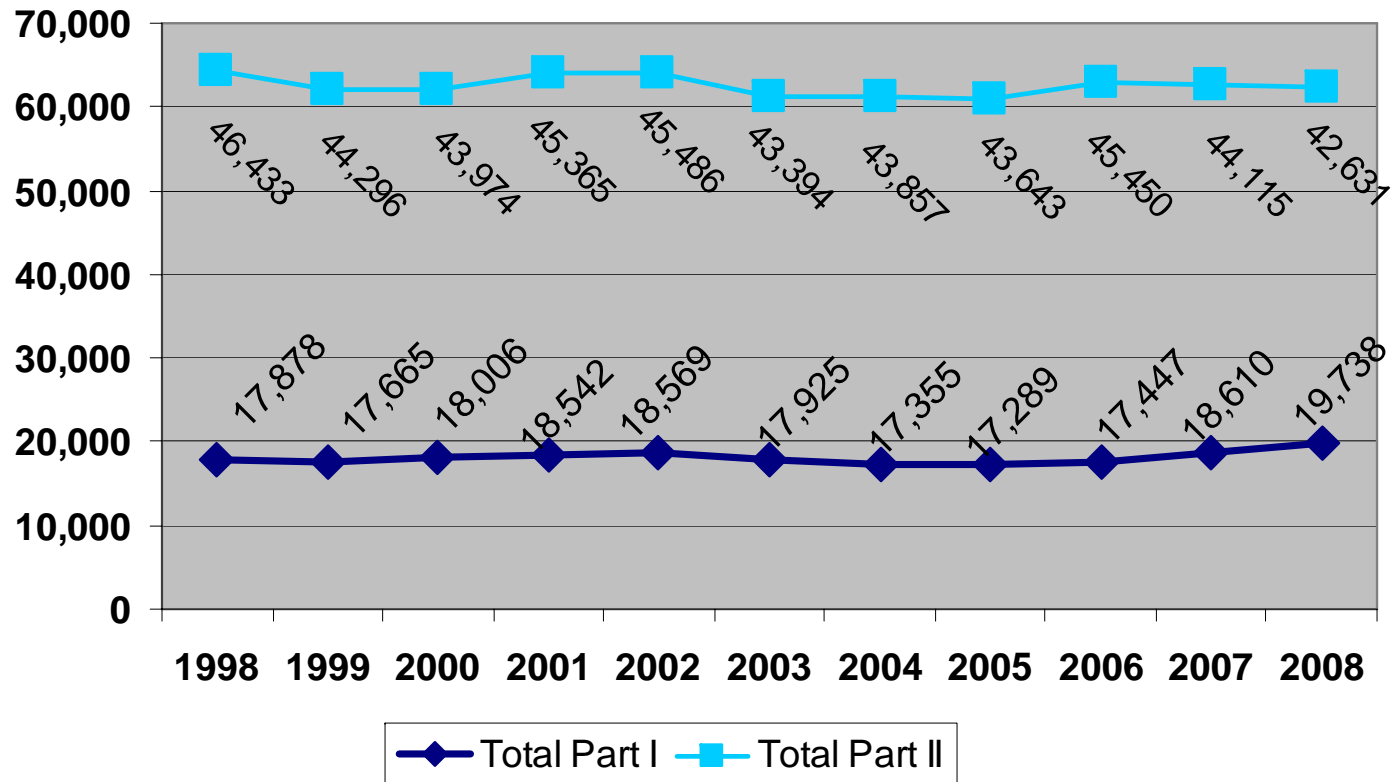


Part I Crimes 1998 - 2008



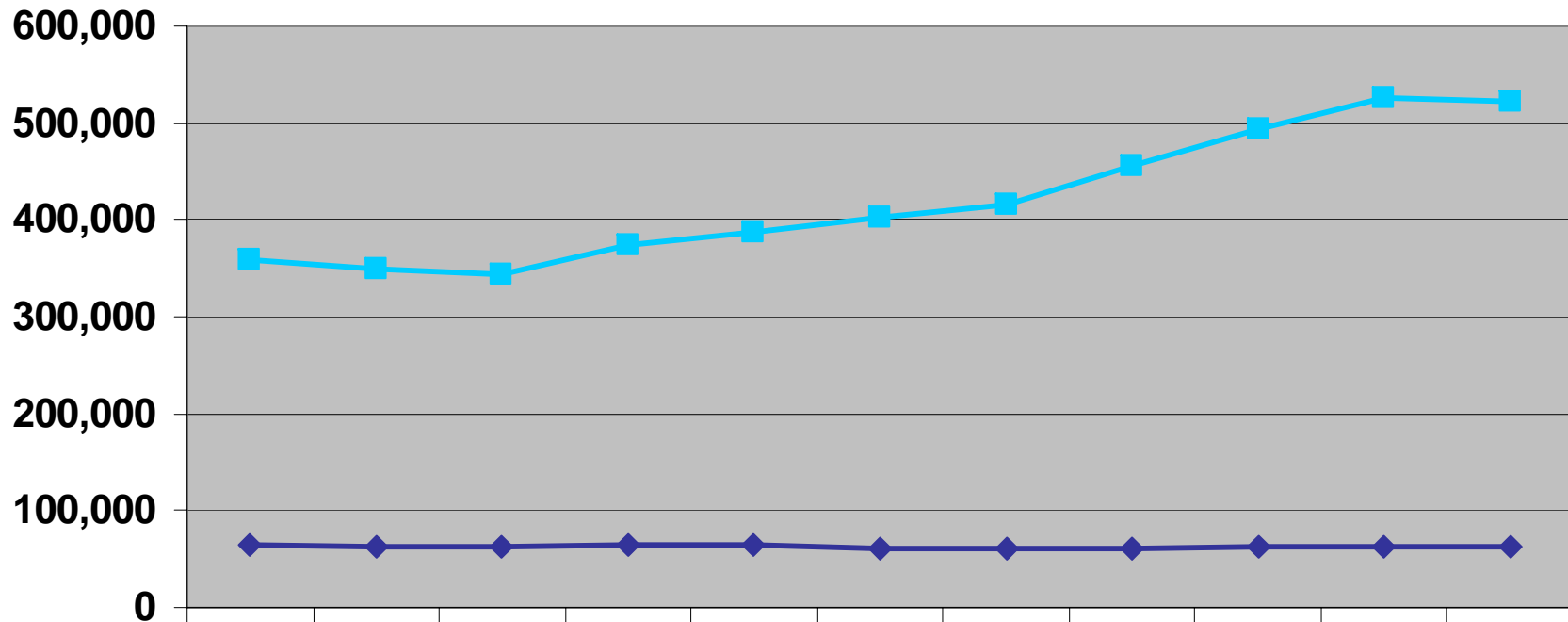
