I. PURPOSE

This directive explains the jurisdiction of the department and its police officers.

II. JURISDICTION IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY

The Anne Arundel County Police Department exercises full law enforcement jurisdiction within the geographic confines of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, as they are defined in the Anne Arundel County Charter. All employees are issued or have access to a current copy of the Anne Arundel County, MD, Street Map© published by the Alexandria Drafting Company. The geographic boundaries of the county are depicted in that publication.

The County is bordered on the north by the City of Baltimore and Baltimore County; on the east by the Chesapeake Bay; on the south by Calvert County; and on the west by Howard County, Prince George's County, and the City of Laurel.

III. UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT PROPERTY

In the absence of written authorization to the contrary, the department exercises no law enforcement jurisdiction on those areas of the county owned or reserved by the United States, including:

- A. U.S. Army General Services Depot, Curtis Bay. Map coordinates 3-F9/**4939-G9**.
- B. U.S. Coast Guard Yard, Curtis Bay. Map coordinates 3-H8/**4939-J8**.
- C. Fort George G. Meade, Maryland. (Jurisdiction has been granted in the public school buildings and grounds, and on certain highways -- see Index Code 106).
- D. U.S. Naval Academy, and Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium, Annapolis.
- E. U.S. Coast Guard Station, map coordinates 26-C7/**5537-D3**.
- F. U.S. Military Reservation, Davidsonville, coordinates 23-F11/**5534-F6**.
- G. **Naval Station Annapolis**, map coordinates 21-C7/**5295-F2**.
- H. U.S. Air Force Transmitter Station, map coordinates 17-J12/**5414-A6**.
- I. Property owned or occupied by the National Security Agency.
- J. **New Beginnings Youth Development Center**, map coordinates 5-G1/**5170-F5**.

IV. MARYLAND STATE POLICE

The Maryland State Police exercises concurrent law enforcement jurisdiction in Anne Arundel County. Emergency calls for service received via the 911 Center are apportioned according to any agreements currently in force. See Index Code 106 for the terms of concurrent jurisdiction agreements.

V. CITY OF ANNAPOLIS

The Annapolis Police Department exercises primary jurisdiction within the geographic boundaries of the incorporated City of Annapolis, as it appears in the the Anne Arundel County, MD, Street Map. Anne Arundel County Police officers possess full law enforcement authority in the City of Annapolis and are expected to take appropriate law enforcement action when no Annapolis police officers are available.

VI. CROFTON

Anne Arundel County Police officers possess full law enforcement authority in the Crofton Special Tax District and are expected to take appropriate law enforcement action when officers of the Crofton Police Department are not available.
