

Pin/Recognition	Proponent Unit	Description
Aviation Wings - Pilot	Special Operations Division	Naval aviator type wings with Maryland seal and star. Worn by helicopter or fixed wing pilots who have successfully completed a police operations flight course and are flight certified to operate police aircraft.
Aviation Wings - Tactical Flight Officer/Observer	Special Operations Division	Naval aviator type wings with Maryland seal, but no star. Worn by those officers who have successfully completed training in aerial observation, tactical flight officer duties, day/night infrared and optical imaging, search and rescue, drug eradication flight operations and/or night operations.
Crisis Negotiation Team Crest	Special Operations Division	Is worn by those who have successfully completed the basic crisis negotiation training and who is a current or past member of the CNT team.
Drill Instructor	Training Academy	A lettered "DI" pin w/ laurel leaves. Worn by those officers who are <u>currently</u> certified as Drill Instructors by the Police Training Academy.
FBI National Academy	Chief's Office	FBI NA logo Worn by those commanders who have successfully completed a course of study at the FBI National Academy
Field Training Officer	Training Academy	Lettered "FTO" pin. Worn by those officers who are <u>currently</u> certified as a FTO.
Canine Officer (K9)	Special Operations Division	Lettered "K9" pin. Worn to distinguish current canine handlers on the class A and B uniforms.
Motor Wings Basic	Special Operations Division	Crest containing a wheel with wings. Recognizes successful completion of the 80-hour basic motor operator's course for police motorcyclists.
Motor Wings - Instructor	Special Operations Division	Crest containing a wheel with wings and an "Instructor" banner. Recognition an additional 80-120 hours of additional training on police motorcycles. Requires Maryland Police and Correctional Training Center's instructor certificate and must successfully teach a basic operator's course before certification.
Motor Wings - Master	Special Operations Division	Crest containing a wheel with wings and a "Master" banner. Recognizes those individuals who have successfully taught both the basic operator's course and the instructor motorcycle operator's course. The wearer must also be a MPCTC Emergency Vehicle Operator's Course instructor.
Civil Disturbance Unit	Special Operations Division	Lettered "CDU" pin. Worn by those officers, supervisors and commanders who are active members of the CDU. Lettering is silver for sergeants and below and gold for commanders.
Narcotics Crest	Special Enforcement Section	Crest is worn by those members who have served in the Narcotics Division/TNT/Special Enforcement for a minimum required time period and who have successfully obtained a minimum of 60 hours of advanced training.
Northwestern School of Police and Staff	Chief's Office	NWSPS logo. Worn by those commanders who have completed a course of study at the Northwestern School of Police and Staff
Quick Response Team	Special Operations Division	Lettered "QRT" pin. Worn by those officers who have attended an approved special weapons and tactics course for law enforcement officers and successfully completed a minimum of 120 hours of approved special weapons and tactics training.
Special Operations Section Crest	Special Operations Division	Is worn by those who have served a required minimum mandatory time in the Special Operations Section or completed the minimum qualifications as a member of the decentralized QRT team.
Shooting Medal	Training Academy	Earned level of expertise based on qualifying scores as established by the Training Academy.
School Resource Officers	Special Enforcement Section	Lettered "SRO" pin. Worn by <u>current</u> School Resource Officers.
