



2009-2010 Men's 50 & Over League Basketball

1. All leagues are governed by the Anne Arundel County Recreation and Parks Guidelines and Reference Manual which is available online at:

2. Leagues will be played by NCAA rules with the below exceptions.
3. General League Information:
 - a. All players must have the same color shirts with numbers.
 - b. Ten minute forfeit time for the first game of the league. Forfeit time for all other games is the scheduled time.
 - a. The forfeiting team must pay **BOTH** officials fees before the start of their next game.
 - b. A team that forfeits two games is subject to disqualification from the league.
 - c. Game time: 20 minute halves with running clock
 - a. Stop clock last 30 seconds of 1st half and last 1 minute of 2nd half (Unless 10 pts. or more difference). Two-minute stopped clock overtimes.
 - d. Four (4) time outs per team per game. All 30 second timeouts.
 - e. Each team may have **one** player on the roster between the ages of 45 and 50. Must be the required age on game day.
 - f. Rosters are unlimited. Each player must have signed the Team Roster Form prior to participation. Team Rosters are to be turned in at the first game. Players can be added through the first six (6) games.
 - g. By their regulations, the officials are not allowed to referee games that have been forfeited for a lack of players.
 - h. Substitutions can be made following a made basket. Players must be at the score table.
 - i. When schools are closed due to inclement weather or the Anne Arundel County Snow Emergency Plan is in effect one (1) hour prior to the first game, games will be canceled.

4. Disputes and Disciplinary Issues:

- a. The Gym Supervisor will handle on court disputes.
- b. Sports Supervisor, Jeff Brazier, will handle protests and disciplinary problems.

5. Suspensions:

- a. Any player or coach who initiates a physical confrontation with an official will be automatically suspended from **ALL** County-sponsored sports for a **MINIMUM** period of two (2) years.
- b. Players ejected for unsportsmanlike conduct will be suspended from play for a minimum of two weeks from all leagues.
- c. Players ejected for fighting will be suspended for a period of time to be determined.
