Dear Voter:

One of the responsibilities of the Anne Arundel County Board of Elections is to appoint Election Judges to staff the Anne Arundel County polling places for the 2018 Gubernatorial Elections. Election Judges are being recruited to work the June 26, 2018 Primary Election and the November 6, 2018 General Election.

All Election Judges, including returning Election Judges, must complete an application. Prior service does not guarantee placement in the polling location you served during the last election. Positions will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis. Please read and complete the entire application. There are several ways to return your application, including:

- 2. As an Election Judge I will arrive to my polling place at the assigned time. I will not leave the polling place, for any reason, at any time during Early Voting or on Election Day while the polls are open.
- 3. I agree to be courteous, respectful, and assist all voters regardless of national origin, race, creed, gender, age, physical challenge or proficiency in the English language.
- 4. I am prepared to fulfill my responsibility to conduct the election according to federal, state and local election laws.
- 5. I agree not to take out or use my personal cell phone at any time while the polls are open. Unless I am a Chief Judge, in which case, I am permitted to use my personal cell phone to communicate with the Anne Arundel County Board of Elections Help Desk. I agree not to bring or use any electronic devices, excluding medical devices, at any time in the polls on Election Day.
- 6. I understand I cannot bring children and/or pets to the Election Judge training class or to the polls on Election Day.
- 7. I understand that if I am under 18 years of age, I must have a parent or guardian’s written permission to be an election judge.
