**BILL NO. 34-17 (As Amended)** - AN ORDINANCE concerning: Licenses – Towing Companies – Police-initiated Tows – FOR the purpose of defining certain terms; repealing provisions allowing for the creation of rules, regulations, and procedures applicable to certain licensed towing companies; allowing forms be used to regulate certain licensed towing companies; amending certain licensing provisions related to the marking and inspection of tow trucks, qualification of tow truck drivers, and additional standards for police towers; adding a provision related to the storage of police-initiated tows; revising provisions for inspection and release of towed vehicles and personal property in towed vehicles; amending provisions related to the tow rotation list and dispatch procedures related to police-initiated tows from rotation list calls; adding certain administrative procedures for companies performing police-initiated tows; requiring certain equipment be kept on tow trucks used for police-initiated tows; establishing procedures for handling debris, unclaimed vehicles, and complaints; and generally relating to the licensing of certain towing companies performing towing at the request of the Police Department.

**BILL NO. 59-17 (As Amended)** – AN ORDINANCE concerning: Public Safety – Animal Control – Dangerous and Vicious Animals (Lilo’s Law) – FOR the purpose of ~~repealing the definition of “potentially dangerous animal” and other relevant references;~~ adding a definition of “vicious animal”; amending the public safety threat provisions to include dangerous and vicious animals; amending the dangerous animal order provisions and conditions to be considered; allowing the impoundment or destruction of vicious and dangerous animals; prohibiting the keeping of vicious animals in the County; establishing a dangerous animal registry in the County; amending the provision regarding confidentiality of records of violations to include the dangerous animal registry; adding conditions that allow the impoundment of animals; amending the provision regarding disposition of animals to include dangerous and vicious animals; and generally relating to Animal Control.

**BILL NO. 60-17 (As Amended)** - AN ORDINANCE the issuance, sale and delivery of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, general obligation bonds and bond anticipation notes – FOR the purpose of authorizing the issuance by Anne Arundel County, Maryland, of bond anticipation notes in an amount to be outstanding at any time not in excess of Four Hundred Million Dollars (\$400,000,000) and bonds in an amount not exceeding ~~One Billion Ninety One Million Nine Hundred One Thousand Nine Hundred Four Dollars (\$1,091,901,904)~~ One Billion Eighty-Four Million One Hundred Two Thousand Three Hundred Ninety-Eight Dollars (\$1,084,102,398) in order to finance in whole or in part the construction of capital projects set forth in the capital budget of the County for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, or in such capital budgets for prior fiscal years, or usable portions thereof; etc.

**BILL NO. 61-17 (As Amended)** - AN ORDINANCE concerning: Personnel – Positions in the Classified Service – FOR the purpose of modifying titles and grades for certain classifications in the classified service; increasing and decreasing certain positions in the classified service; providing for the applicability of this Ordinance; and generally relating to personnel.

**BILL NO. 63-17 (Hearing Concluded) (Eligible for Vote) (To be Withdrawn)** - AN ORDINANCE concerning: Deferred Retirement Option Programs – Fire Service Retirement Plan, Police Service Retirement Plan, and Detention Officers’ and Deputy Sheriffs’ Retirement Plan – FOR the purpose of modifying reemployment provisions for certain retirees who participated in Deferred Retirement Option Programs; modifying general provisions relating to reemployment of retirees; providing for the application of this Ordinance; and generally relating to retirement plans.

BILL NO. 64-17 (As Amended) - AN ORDINANCE concerning: Zoning – Accessory Structures – Sheds, Garages, and Similar Structures – FOR the purpose of allowing sheds, garages, or similar structures as accessory structures on a lot without a principal structure under certain circumstances; limiting the floor area of certain sheds, garages, or similar structures constructed as accessory structures; ~~exempting sheds, garages, or similar structures built as accessory structures from lot merger requirements;~~ and generally relating to zoning.
