BILL NO. 65-17 - AN ORDINANCE concerning: Office of Planning and Zoning and Department of Inspections and Permits – Reorganization of Duties and Responsibilities – FOR the purpose of reorganizing certain duties and responsibilities of the Office of Planning and Zoning and the Department of Inspections and Permits pertaining to real property tax credits for stormwater management, erosion and sediment control, stormwater management, subdivision and development, and zoning; clarifying “qualified improvements” for stormwater management; and generally relating to the Office of Planning and Zoning and the Department of Inspections and Permits.

BILL NO. 25-17 (As Amended) (Amendments Proposed) – AN ORDINANCE concerning: Zoning – Agritourism – FOR the purpose of Zoning and Construction and Property Maintenance Codes Supplement – Construction Code Administrative Provisions – Agritourism – Permits – Agricultural Buildings – FOR the purpose of exempting certain agricultural buildings from the building permit requirements of the Construction Code; defining certain terms; allowing agritourism and farm product local distribution centers as conditional uses as a conditional use in certain residential districts; allowing equestrian centers as a special exception use in certain residential districts; allowing pets, livestock or fowl under certain circumstances in certain commercial and industrial districts; allowing nurseries with landscaping and plant sales as a conditional use in certain open space districts; establishing the conditional use requirements for agritourism uses and farm product local distribution centers; amending the conditional use requirements for stables or riding clubs; establishing the special exception use requirements for equestrian centers; and generally relating to zoning and the Construction Codes

BILL NO. 28-17 (As Amended) (Hearing Concluded) (Eligible for Vote) - AN ORDINANCE concerning: Finance, Taxation, and Budget – Admissions and Amusement Tax – Agritourism – FOR the purpose of defining certain terms; creating an exemption to the admissions and amusement tax for agritourism and certain other uses; updating pertinent State law references; providing for the effective date of the exemption to the admissions and amusement tax; providing for a certain contingency on the effective date of this bill; and generally relating to admissions and amusement taxes.

BILL NO. 34-17 (As Amended) - AN ORDINANCE concerning: Licenses – Towing Companies – Police-initiated Tows – FOR the purpose of defining certain terms; repealing provisions allowing for the creation of rules, regulations, and procedures applicable to certain licensed towing companies; allowing forms be used to regulate certain licensed towing companies; amending certain licensing provisions related to the marking and inspection of tow trucks, qualification of tow truck drivers, and additional standards for police towers; adding a provision related to the storage of police-initiated tows; revising provisions for inspection and release of towed vehicles and personal property in towed vehicles; amending provisions related to the tow rotation list and dispatch procedures related to police-initiated tows from rotation list calls; adding certain administrative procedures for companies performing police-initiated tows; requiring certain equipment be kept on tow trucks used for police-initiated tows; establishing procedures for handling debris, unclaimed vehicles, and complaints; and generally relating to the licensing of certain towing companies performing towing at the request of the Police Department.

BILL NO. 35-17(Public Hearing Continued)(TO BE WITHDRAWN) - AN ORDINANCE concerning: Income Tax – Cybersecurity Investment Incentive Tax Credit Supplement – FOR the purpose of defining “cybersecurity company”; establishing an income tax credit supplement for certain cybersecurity companies; establishing eligibility for the credit; providing for calculation of the credit; providing for payment of the credit; providing a penalty for fraudulent applications; establishing recapture procedures; establishing a termination date for the credit; and generally related to income taxes.

BILL NO. 52-17 (As Amended) – AN ORDINANCE concerning: Woodland Beach Special Community Benefit District – Approval of Loan Agreement – FOR the purpose of obligating the County to levy the special tax known as the special community benefit assessment on the Woodland Beach Special Community Benefit District in an amount sufficient to repay a loan from Severn Savings Bank, FSB to the London Towne Property Owners’ Association, Inc. in each of ten (10) fiscal years during the term of the loan.
