The Office of Transportation will comply with the following process and procedures for the reopening of 2664 Riva Road facility for the general public and commissions.

Commissions and Board associated with the Office of Transportation will work with the office to identify logistics to provide the safe setup for in person meetings. Hybrid options will be available for those that wish to participate remotely.
