The Lord bless you because you have shown this kindness to my two sons.

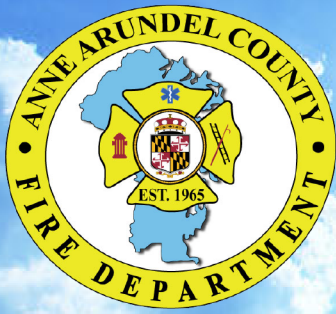

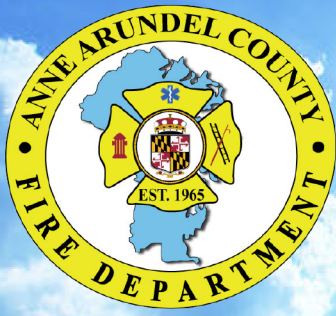

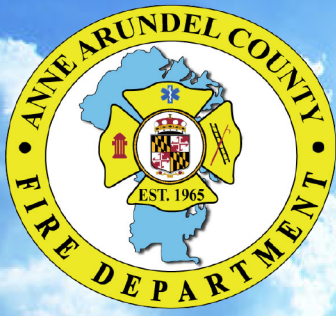

I'm writing to express my gratitude for the incredible firefighters who came to our aid last week. We have a wood burning fireplace in our home in Anne Arundel County and last week we had our first experience with a chimney fire. We were watching a Christmas movie with family members who had just arrived from out of town, when a sound like a jet engine started roaring from the fireplace. I used our fire extinguisher to put out the fire but we decided to err on the safe side and call 911. Just a few minutes later the first firetruck arrived with AA County's finest. I found out later that 9 or 10 vehicles arrived in total.

The firefighting team quickly went to work and checked the interior and exterior of the house, inspected the attic and even extended a ladder truck so one brave firefighter (LT Holland) could get on the roof to inspect the top of the chimney. Thank goodness there was no damage to the interior or exterior of the house and Chief Brett and LT Casey told us we did the right thing calling 911. As recommended by the team, we had our chimney inspected last week and we're pleased to report there was no damage and we're told its safe to begin burning fires again.

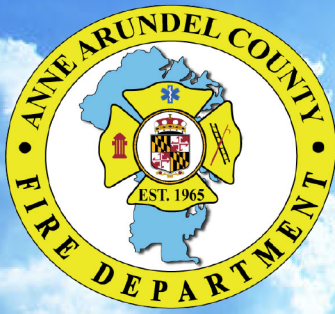
I just wanted to take a minute to send this email to thank the team for the quick response and thorough inspection of our house so that our family could sleep soundly knowing the house was safe.
