Background and History

- The existing WB&A Trail lies on either side of the Patuxent
- The Anne Arundel portion is located off of Conway Road
- Connected bridge will be part of the East Coast Greenway, and connect Washington, DC to Wilmington, DE
- Feasibility study conducted in 2017
- 2019- Permitting process underway

Key Project Information

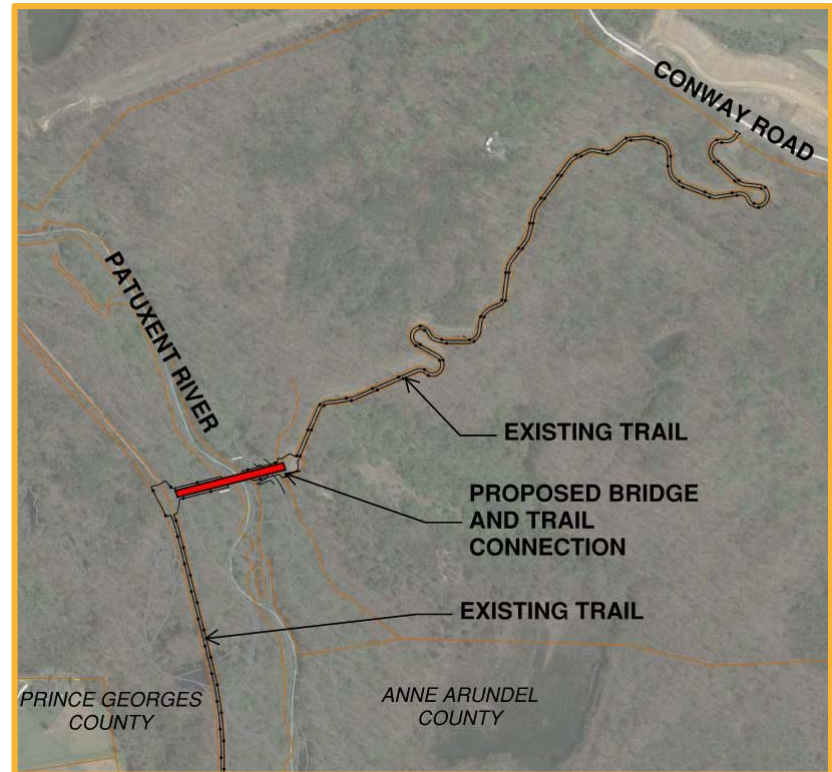

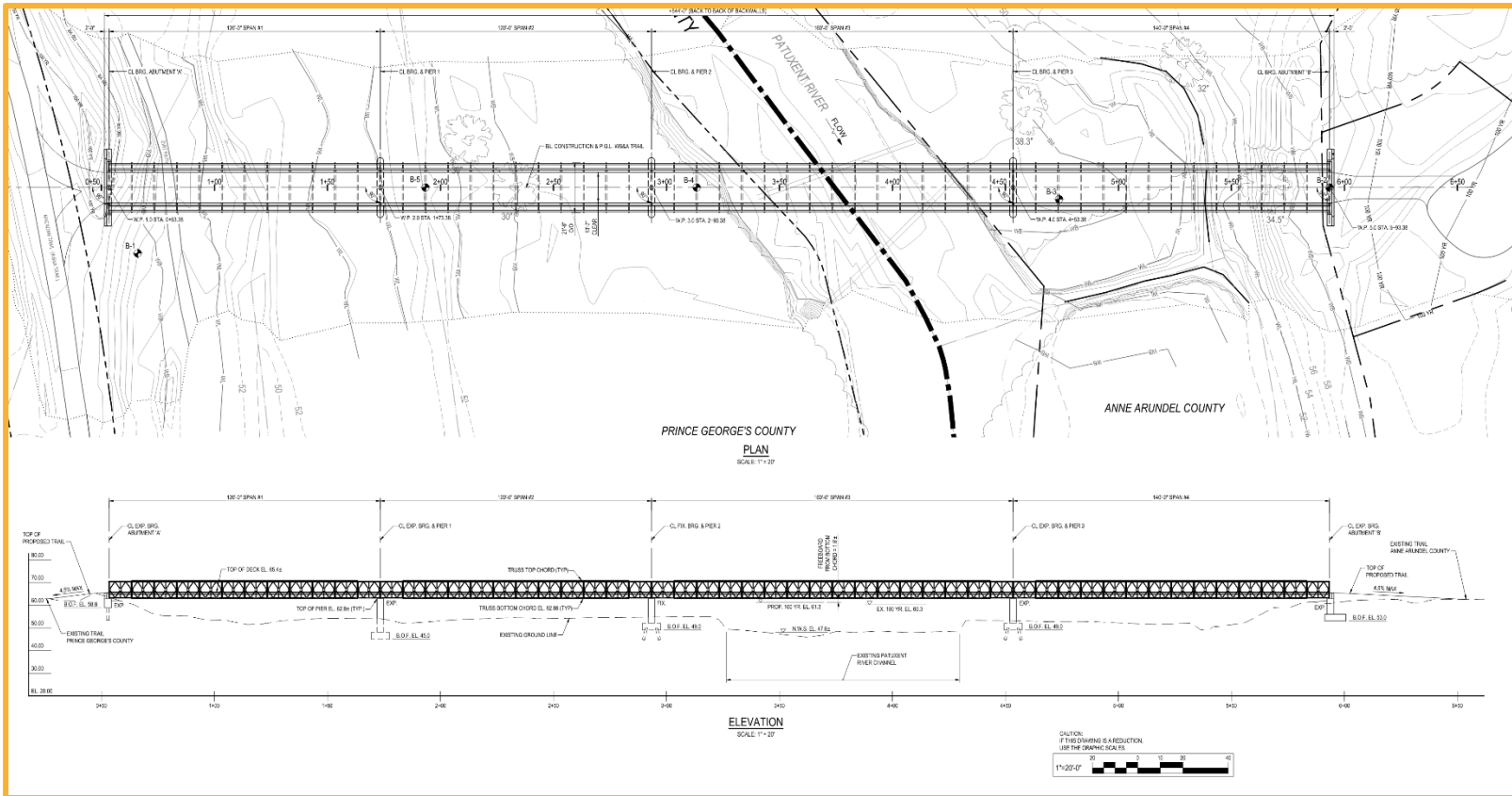
