Eastern Beach Improvements

- 1. Demolish existing concrete block structures including the public restroom/shower buildings, the maintenance building, and wastewater treatment plant.
- 2. Construct a New Comfort/Concession building with food service and public restrooms. It will be a 1-story building containing 3,987 square feet of interior space.
- 3. Construct new asphalt paved parking lot containing a total of 120 spaces; 8 of these are accessible spaces.



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


New Maintenance Building


- 1. Construct a new 1-story 5,200 square foot building
- 2. Exterior: Secured fenced in yard with slide gates, paved yard/storage area and 8 parking spaces.
