### **Project Background**

- Location Chesapeake Bay on John Downs Loop, Pasadena, MD
- Approximately 238-acre park area which includes an amphitheater, natural areas, picnic area, playground, fishing pier, dog beach, kayak launch, walking trails and approximately 2,250 Linear Feet of shoreline.
- The current dog beach does not comply with ADA Accessibility Requirements.
- Storms resulted in coastal erosion and damage to infrastructure.





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### **Downs Park Existing Conditions - Existing Dog Beach**

- Secluded beach area (4,300 SF) adjacent to private property
- Access through steep slopes and stairs that is not ADA-Compliant











#### **Downs Park Existing Conditions - Existing Beach**

- Narrow beach eroding at ± 1 foot/year
- Emergency path repairs for storm damage after October 2021 storm







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#### **Downs Park Existing Conditions - Revetment**

- Wash-out areas from wave overtopping
- Undersized stone displaced during large wave events

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
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





#### **Proposed Design - Dog Beach**








#### **Proposed Design - Revetment**


- Restore ±360 feet of revetment
- Enhance with larger stone interlocked to increase stability
- Raise crest elevation +8.0 feet MLW



#### **Accessibility Improvements**

- 185-feet long, 8-feet wide path constructed with permeable pavers
- Resurfaced paved path from Fernwood parking lot to permeable paver path for full ADA-accessibility from parking to dog beach













### Habitat Enhancement Areas

- Canopy Trees (e.g., Red Maple, River Birch, Swamp White Oak)
- Understory Trees (e.g., Flowering Dogwood, Downy Serviceberry, Sweetbay Magnolia)
- Shrubs (e.g., Red Chokeberry, Coastal Sweetpepperbush, Beach Plum, Virginia Sweetspire)
- Herbaceous Plugs (e.g., Salt Meadow Cordgrass, Smooth Coordgrass)



Mitigation Planting Quantities	
Canopy Trees	21
Understory Trees	9
Shrubs	90
Herbaceous Plugs	14,700
