10	time to carefully evaluate and reconsider and revise workplace provisions for the
11	legislative branch is upon us; and
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13	WHEREAS, Section 303 of the Charter allows the Council to appoint special ad
14	hoc committees solely for the purpose of inquiry and fact finding; now, therefore,

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1 Resolved, That the Ad Hoc Committee shall, in the course of its work and as a part of its final recommendations:

1. Study other counties and compare similarities and differences in the administration of personnel or human relations laws;

2. Study and report the level of oversight that Anne Arundel County's Personnel Officer retains over the legislative branch;

3. Make recommendations for annual performance reviews of exempt and appointed employees in the legislative branch;

4. Make recommendations for an employee relations manual for the employees of the legislative branch; and

5. Make any related recommendations for amendments or additions to the provisions of the County Charter or Code that apply to the legislative branch;

and be it further

Resolved, That the Ad Hoc Committee shall submit a final report to the County Council not later than December 31, 2024.
