1 RESOLUTION proposing an amendment to the Charter of Anne Arundel County to
2 require that all meetings and legislative sessions of the County Council comply with the
3 Maryland Open Meetings Act

5 *Be it resolved by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That the*
6 *following amendment to the Anne Arundel County Charter is proposed for submission to*
7 *the qualified voters of the County at the General Election in November 2024:*

9 **Article III. The Legislative Branch**

10 **Sec. 307. Legislative Procedure.**

11 (a) **Public Meetings.** All meetings and legislative sessions of the County Council shall
12 ~~[[be open to the public]]~~ COMPLY WITH THE MARYLAND OPEN MEETINGS ACT.

16 *And be it further resolved, That the following question is adopted for submittal to the*
17 *qualified voters of the County at the General Election in November 2024 for their adoption*
18 *or rejection:*

20 “To amend the Anne Arundel County Charter to require that all meetings and
21 legislative sessions of the County Council comply with the Maryland Open Meetings Act.”

23 *And be it further resolved, That this question shall be designated as Question “__” on*
24 *the ballot at the General Election in November 2024.*

26 *And be it further resolved, That if the majority of qualified votes cast in the election*
27 *are for the Charter Amendment, this amendment shall stand adopted from and after the 30th*
28 *day following the election.*
