A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE concerning: Agricultural Preservation Advisory Board

3 FOR the purpose of providing for appointment to and service on the Agricultural
4 Preservation Advisory Board by certain persons under certain circumstances,
5 notwithstanding certain provisions of the Anne Arundel County Public Ethics Law;
6 making this Ordinance an emergency measure; and providing for the application of this
7 Ordinance.

9 BY adding: Article 24, §2-202(e)
10 Anne Arundel County Code (1985, as amended)

12 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*
13 That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (1985, as amended) read as follows:

15 **ARTICLE 24 PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT**
16 **Title 2. Agricultural Land Preservation**

18 2-202. Agricultural Preservation Advisory Board.

20 (E) (1) NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 9 OF THIS CODE, A PERSON
21 MAY BE APPOINTED TO AND MAY SERVE ON THE AGRICULTURAL PRESERVATION
22 ADVISORY BOARD EVEN IF THE PERSON HAS A DISTRICT AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE
23 OR COUNTY OR HAS SOLD AN EASEMENT ON THE PERSON'S AGRICULTURAL LAND OR
24 WOODLAND TO THE STATE OR COUNTY.

26 (2) NOTHING IN THIS SUBSECTION EXCUSES A MEMBER OF THE AGRICULTURAL
27 PRESERVATION ADVISORY BOARD FROM COMPLIANCE WITH ARTICLE 9, §3-101 OF THIS
28 CODE.

29
30 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Ordinance shall be construed
31 retroactively and shall be applied to and interpreted to affect incumbent members of the
32 Agricultural Preservation Advisory Board on the date that this Ordinance takes effect.

1 SECTION 3. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an
2 emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,
3 health, safety, welfare, and property, and being passed by the affirmative vote of five
4 members of the County Council, the same shall take effect from the date it becomes law.


