SUBJECT: 2022 Gubernatorial General Election Public Demonstration of the Voting System

In accordance with the Code of Maryland Regulations (COMAR), Title 33.10.01.16, at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, October 13, 2022, the Anne Arundel County Board of Elections will conduct the pre-election public demonstration of the logic and accuracy test for the voting units to be used for the November 8, 2022 Gubernatorial General Election. The public will also be allowed to inspect the printouts of results from the pre-election testing.

The public demonstration will be conducted at the Anne Arundel County Board of Elections office located on 6740 Baymeadow Drive, Glen Burnie, Maryland, 21060.

Additionally, COMAR Title 33.10.01.16 states that "...one representative of each political party, and one representative of each candidate who is not a candidate of a political party is entitled to be present at the demonstration." Please also be aware that the Anne Arundel County Board of Elections will conduct Mail-in Ballot and Provisional Ballot Canvasses at the Anne Arundel County Board of Elections office on the following dates:

| ● Mail-in Ballot Canvass | 10:00 a.m. | Tuesday, November 15th |
| ● Provisional Ballot & Mail-in Ballot Canvass | 10:00 a.m. | Wednesday, November 16th |
| ● Mail-in Ballot Canvass** | 10:00 a.m. | Thursday, November 17th |
| ● Final Mail-in Ballot Canvass** | 10:00 a.m. | Friday, November 18th |

Please contact me if you have any questions or need additional information. The Board may schedule additional canvass days or cancel scheduled canvass days depending on the volume of voted ballots returned by mail. Please check the Board of Elections website at aacounty.org/elections for the latest canvassing schedule.

*The Board will announce a decision to canvass mail-in ballots on Monday at the conclusion of the canvass on Thursday, November 10th.

**Canvass may include Provisional Ballots voted during Early Voting or on Election Day if multiple Provisional Ballot canvassing days are needed.
