We want to thank the over two thousand people who have responded with interest in becoming an election judge for the 2022 Gubernatorial Election cycle, we will be sending you an Election Judge Application for the 2022 Gubernatorial Election cycle. As noted in last month's newsletter, a new application to become an Election Judge is required by Maryland law for each election cycle.

For those persons from whom we have yet to receive a reply, you have several ways of letting us know you are interested in serving as an Election Judge in 2022 or if you wish to be removed from our list. #### ***Getting in Summer Mindset Recipes***

##### **Homemade Guacamole**

3 ripe avocados, peeled and cubed  
1 garlic clove, minced  
1/4 to 1/2 teaspoon salt  
1 small onion, finely chopped  
1 to 2 tablespoon lime juice  
1 tablespoon minced fresh cilantro  
2 medium tomatoes, seeded and chopped  
1/4 cup mayonnaise

Mash avocados with garlic and salt. Stir in remaining ingredients. **Enjoy!**

##### **Fizzy Peach Shake**

3 medium peaches, pitted  
1/3 cup ginger ale, chilled  
2 tables honey  
1 quart vanilla ice cream  
Optional: Whipped cream and peach slices

Place peaches, ginger ale and honey in a blender; cover and process until smooth. Add ice cream and blend until smooth. Pour into glass and garnish with whip cream and peach slices.
