The 2020 Election Judge application is available online on the Anne Arundel County Board of Elections website. The earlier we receive your application the greater your chance of working at your preferred polling location.

Election Judge Recruitment

We are recruiting 2,800 Election Judges for the 2020 Presidential Election cycle and have already received many applications. We strongly encourage all of our returning Election Judges to submit your 2020 Election Judge Application **now!**

We need to recruit 300 new election judges, in addition to our returning election judges. If you know anyone that has expressed an interest in serving as an election judge, they should contact us at 410-222-0494.

We will be holding Election Judge Information Sessions for all new election judges in April and May. These Information Sessions will be 90 minutes in length and will take those in attendance behind the scenes in the Election Office, walk them through the processes during an election cycle as well as explaining the roles and responsibilities of our Election Judges.

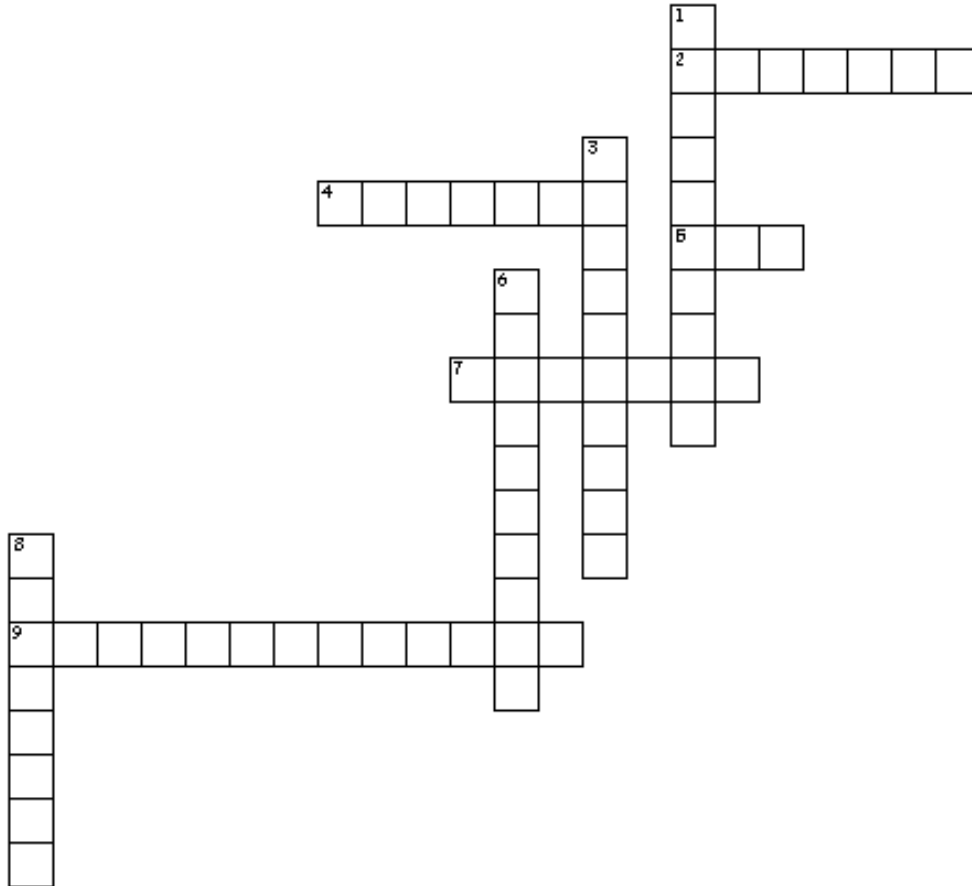
