The Importance of Voter Outreach:

We all recognize the importance of voting. In a 2018 Pew Research Center survey, 74 percent of responders ranked election participation as a very important determinant of good citizenship—above paying taxes and following the law.

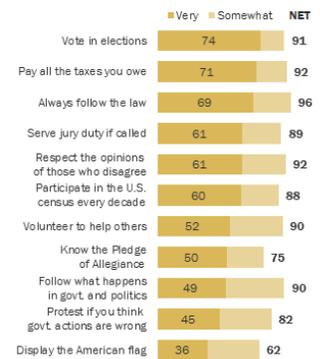
When people exercise their power as voters, they can elect local, state and national leaders who are responsive to and reflective of the communities they serve.

To increase voter participation and expand voting opportunities for eligible voters, each state has a variety of tools that they use to increase voter participation. In Maryland, we utilize Online Voter Registration, registering 16 and 17 year olds so that they will be eligible to vote at 18. In addition, starting July 2019 Maryland will begin utilizing Automatic Registration and October 2019 we will start Same Day Registration on Election Day.

And while these are all great tools to help with getting every eligible citizen registered to vote and involved in the democratic process, the voter outreach department is one of the most important links in our process.

Anne Arundel County Board of Elections has a great voter outreach coordinator, Joshua Ramos. Josh has worked with the Board of Elections for 33 years and has been in charge of voter outreach since May 2017, and it is a role that he is very passionate about. Josh enjoys being able to assist voters with registration, recruiting election judges and explaining the voting process to the future generations. He has a great team of voter registration volunteers that he trains to help him with the many tasks and events that he oversees. Josh, along with his voter registration volunteers stay busy attending festivals and fairs, registration drives and school events to bring the registration and election information to the voters. We offered the first of the New Election Judge Information Session's for applicants that have not previously served as an Election Judge. The feedback that we received from the attendees was very positive .

The session will be approximately one and a half hours long and will review the basics of being an Election Judge, tour the Board of Elections Office and answer any questions.

2020 Election Judges

We would like to thank the 1700 election judges that have submitted their applications for the 2020 Presidential Election Cycle, and encourage you to submit your application as soon as possible.

You will have a better chance of being placed at the polling location of your choice if we receive your completed application in a timely manner.

We have began scheduling the positions for the 2020 Presidential Primary and at this time have scheduled 405 of the 2735 election judges needed. We will be calling the election judge applicants as the applications are received.

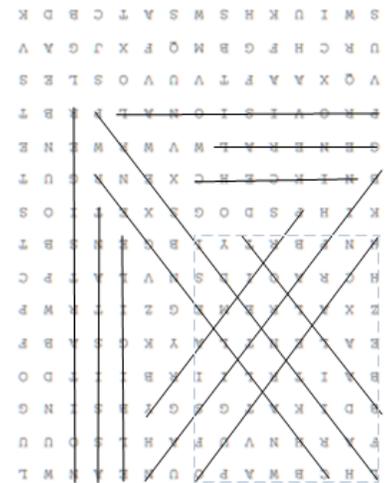
