#### **Preparing for the 2022 Gubernatorial Election Cycle**

We are sending the March edition of our Election Judge Newsletter to everyone who either worked or applied to work as an election judge during the 2018 and 2020 election cycles for which we have an email address. While we are still over a year away from the 2022 Gubernatorial Election cycle, we want to encourage everyone to consider working the primary election on June 28, 2022 and the general election on November 8, 2022. A new application to become an Election Judge is required by Maryland law for each election cycle. We will be sending an application to everyone on our list later this year unless you let us know that you are no longer interested in working as an Election Judge.

The 2021 Maryland General Assembly Session is considering several election law changes. We will detail any legislation that passes the General Assembly during its current session in future newsletters.
